THE Pregnancy of her Royal Highness the Princess of Asturias, who is five Months gone with Child, was notified two Days ago to the Council of Castille; and from thence to the several other Councils throughout the Kingdom; and Publick Prayers are ordered to be put up for her Royal Highness's Safety.

St. James's, June 26.

This Day the Baron de Nolcken, Envoy Extraordinary from the King of Sweden, had a Private Audience of His Majesty, to notify the Death of the late King of Sweden, and to deliver his new Credentials.

To which he was introduced by the Right Honourable the Earl of Suffolk, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State; and conducted by Stephen Cottrell, Esq; Assistant Master of the Ceremonies.

N. B. The Court will appear out of Mourning on the Occasion.
