Stockholm, January 21. The States have been twice assembled in Pleno this last Week, but no Affair of Importance was brought on.

Last Saturday died Count Wrede Sparre, Grand Governor of Stockholm; by which one of the most profitable and important Posts in this Kingdom is become vacant.

The Order of Clergy has sent a Deputation to the other Orders, with an Extract of their Protocol, desiring that they will dispatch the Affairs that are before them, that the Dyet may not be unreasonably lengthened. This was laid upon the Table in the House of Nobles, without being read.

Berlin, January 25. Yesterday, being the King of Prussia's Birth-day, his Majesty received, in the Morning, the Compliments usual on the Occasion, from the Royal Family, Nobility, and Foreign Ministers here. His Majesty afterwards dined at his Brother Prince Henry's Palace with the Queen and Princesses of Sweden, and the rest of the Royal Family. After Dinner his Majesty set out from Potsdam, attended by Lieutenant-General Lentulus.
