ruly fenfible of the many Advantages arifing to us from your Majeity's aufpicious Reign, we can-not, without the greateft Anguifh, behold your Majefty under the heavy Preffure of Domettick Sorrow, and Filial Affliction.

We fincerely wifh, that your Majefty may be fupported, in your prefent Situation, by your ufual Fortitude, and Serenity of Mind; that Occafions of exprefing our Senfibility of your Majefty's Feel-ings may feldom offer; but that your Majefty's Reign may be marked by an uninterrupted Series of Profperity.
