AT the Court at St. James's, the 10th Day of September, 1772,

PRESENT,

The KING's most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREA'S there w. this Day read at the Board the humble Petition of the Governor, Confuls, and Court of Af-filtants of the Ruffia Company, pray-

ing, for the Reafons therein contained, that the Quarantine now subsisting upon all Ships com-ing from the Russian Dominions may be taken off. -And whereas there was likewife read at the Board feveral Letters from His Majefly's Conful at Peterfburgh, reprefenting, that not only in that City, but by Advices from all other Parts of the Empire, they continue entirely free from the late Epidemical Diftemper, notwithstanding the Heat of the Season; and that there is not the least Symptom of the Piague to be found from Jaffy in Moldavia to Petersburgh, every Town and City within the Boundaries of the Ruffian Empire being in good Health.—His Majefty taking the fame into Confideration, and being defirous to remove all Restraints upon Trade, fo far as may be confistent with the Safety of His Subjects, may be comment with the Sarety of Fils Subjects, is pleafed, with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the Quaran-tine at prefent fubfitting, by His Majeity's Order in Council of the 8th of July laft, be taken off, fo far as refpects Ships and Veffels coming from Archan-gel, Peterfburgh, Narva, Riga, or from any other Port or Place in the Dominions of Ruffia; and that All Ships and Veffels aircody arrived, or that may all Ships and Vessels aiready arrived, or that may hereafter arrive, from those Places, be permitted to difcharge their respective Ladings, without unpack-ing, opening, and airing, and without performing any Quarantine, provided that they have no Cotton-Wool on Board; that they bring with them clean Bills of Health; and that the Mafter, or other Per-fon taking Charge of fuch Ship or Veffel, do firft make Oath before the Cuftom house Officer or Chief Magistrate, on their Arrival at the Place where they are bound to, that the Crews are free from all Infection —And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majefty's Treasury, the Com-missioners for Executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Lieutenant-General and the reft of the principal Officers of the Ordnance, His Ma-jefty's Secretary at War, and the Governors or Com-manders in Chief for the Time being of the Isles of Jerfey, Guernley, Alderney, Sark, and Man, are to give the necessfary Directions herein as to them may refpectively appertain.

Florence, August 25. By the Accounts received here of the Wheat Harveft, it appears, that in Piedmont. the Territories of Genoa, Mantua, Ferrara, Venice, and all Lombardy, it has been fo deficient, that they will fland in Need of very large Supplies.
