Dantzicke, Octob 16.

UR Letters arrived the last Week from Poland, gave an account of fome confiderable Rencounters that had happened between the Poles and the lucks and Tartars, and effeally on he 29 patt; which though it concu-

ded with advantage to the former, for that the lof was by much the g cater on the part of the Enemy, yet his Majefty was much troubled at the lofs of feveral brave Poluth Soldiers that were killed, befides those wounded, which were not a few. This morning we have fruin Letters from Lespol, which lay, that the King was encamped fo near the Enemy, that it was hourly expected they would engage in a Battel, which the Polish Soldiers (notwithstanding fo much inferiour to the Turks and Iartars in number) were very eager after.

Vienna, Octob. 15. His Imperial Majefly is at prefent with the Court at Eberdorp, from whence we have an account this moning, that his Imperial M jefly has declared his intended Marringe with the eluel P incefs of Newburg, named Eleanora, Magdalena, Therefia, aged about 21 years; Tl at the fuid Marringe will be celebrated the 15 of the next Month, being the Featl of St Leopold, (which name the Emperor bears) and that the Prince of Dietrichfeyn, High Chamberlain to his Imperial Mafefly, is appointed to go and fetch the Imperial Bride, who is at prefent at the Duke her Fathers Court at Newburg. The lat Letters we received from Poland speak much of the appearance there was of a fudden peace with the Turk;, and that Commissioners were appointed on Both fides, who were to meet and begin the Treaty zbout the middle of this Month.

Ratisbunne, Octob. 17. The 12 inflant the States affembled here, had in debate the point concerning a general Peace, and the means how the fpecieit to procure the fame; and it was then refolved, that the Emperor, fhould be prayed not onely to haiten his own Ambaliadors, but likewife those of his Allies, to the place of-Treaty, where the Ambassadors of England, France and Holland have been already fometime. The Deputy of the Elector of Saxony, who, together with the perion deputed by the Elector of Mentz, were fent to the Eleftor of Bavaria, to prefs him to join his Troops with those of the other Princes of the Empire, is returney, though, as is faid, without any fuecels in their Negotiation, that Elector pecifiting in his refolution to maintain an exact Neutrality.

Copenhagen, Oftob. 17. The King is expected here every day, all the Forces being at prefent in their Winter-quarters in Schonen, except fome which are embarked, in order to the exeruting fome defign, which is kept private. The Sieur Guldenlieu is fuddenly expected here from Norway, in whofe abfence the Sieur Bauditz is to command there. So foon as the King returns hither, we thall kno v when he will give Audience to the Deputies of the Duke of Holffern, who in the name of that. Duke are to receive the inveflure of the Dutchy of Slefwicke. The Dutch Squidron of Men of War is returned home, though Admiral Tranz continues fhill abroad with feveral Danish Men of War. The Sieur Griffen. felt has of late obtained more liberty in Prifon than he had before. It is faid that the Duke of Holliein Ploen, who commanded his Majefiles Forces this Campagne is going for Vienna.

Hamburg, Olibb. 23. Though the Elector of Brandenburg has for fome time been with part of his Forces before Stetin, yet it cannot be faid that that place is formally befieged, for neither the Cannon for Battery, now the I roops employed in the Siege of Demmin, are as yet come up, which multarriv there, before they will begin to break ground; and many are even of opinion to at confidering how far the Wi ter Seafon is advanced, his Electoral Highnefs will on ly keep the place blocked up this Winter; which opinion is confirmed by feveral Letters of the 20 inflant from Let in. From Denmark we mult not expect to heat of any inor a clion this year; for the Army is actually br ke up, and gone into Winter-quarters.

The Deputies of the winterquarters in the Empire in the Brief Cantons are fill affembled at Baden, though we do not hear of any final refolution they have taken, further than to maintain an exact Neutrality in the preferet War.

Strasburg, Octob. 19. The Imperial Army under the command of the Duke of Lorrain, continues encamped at Hieterscheim, not far from Baste ; and two days fince his Highness accompanied with several principal Offi-, cers of the Army, and followed by a guard of 1000 Horfe, was at Newbourg, a fmall place above Brifac, which, it's faid, the faid Duke means to fortifie, in order to the blocking up of Brifac this Winter. There is no more discourse of the Imperialists passing the Rhine; but on the other hand, it's faid, that they will about the latter end of this Month go into their Winter-quarters, in order to which, they expect the return of Count Mans feldt from Vienna. The French Army commanded by the Duke of Luxemburg, continues en-, camped between Mulbaufen and Enfifheym, and befet the feveral Paffages into the Franche Comte ; but the Prince of Mombellard has not yet been perfuaded to receive Garisons from either fide into his places, which he has manned with kis own Subjects, to the number of 2000, being refolved to continue an exact Neutrality The Deputies of the Suisse Cantons continue their Affembly at Baden, and will do fo, as long as the Armies are to near their Territories, that they may be able to take the refolution neceffary upon any incident that may happen.
