The general Concern on this Occafion feems to abforb all other Confiderations, and all Business is for the present at a Stand at the Porte.

Naples, January 18. We hear that the Confuls of the Maestranza at Palermo have petitioned his Sicilian Majesty, that the Duke of Fogliani may return to that City.

The prefent Eruption of Mount Veluvius is very flight; and as the Lava iffues from a Crack very near the Crater, it will probably continue long, and do little Damage, as it cools and stops before it reaches the cultivated Parts of the Mountain.

Laft Week the Great Florence, January 21. Duke apponted Count Alberti, who acts as Director of the War Office, to prefide likewife at the Office of Secretary of State, in the Room of the Chevalier Jeminetti, who has been promoted to the Government of Siena, with the Title of Lieutenant Governor.

Lifbon, January 22. His most faithful Majesty, having been at Salvaterra for a few Days, returned to the Ajuda on the 15th Instant, as usual, for three subsequent Days of Devotion, and went back on the 18th Initant to Salvaterra, where he will remain with the Royal Family till the Beginning of Lent.
