The KING's most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREAS the Time limited by His Majesty's Order in Council of the 19th of October last, for prohibiting the Exporting out of this Kingdom, or carrying Coastwife, Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, will expire upon the 19th Day of this Instant April — And whereas it is judged expedient that the faid Prohibition (hould be continued for fome Time longer - His Majesty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy-Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Per-fon or Perfons whatfoever (except the Mafter-Gene-ral, Lieutenant General, or Principal Officers of the Ordnance, for His Majefty's Service) do, at any Time during the Space of Six Months, to commence from the faid toth Day of this Infant April from the faid 19th Day of this Instant April, pre-fume to transport, into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coastwife, any Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, or thip or lade any Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition on Board any Ship or Veffel, in order to transporting the fame into any Parts beyond the Seas, or carry-ing the fame Coaftwife, without Leave or Permiffion in that Behalf first obtained from His Majesty, or His Privy-Council, upon Pain of incurring and fuf-fering the respective Forfeitures and Penalties inflicted by an Act paffed in the Twenty-ninth Year of His late Majelty's Reign, entituled, "An Act to "impower His Majefty to prohibit the Exportation " of Salt-petre; and to inforce the law for im-" powering His Majefty to prohibit the Exportation " of Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms and Am-" munition; and also to impower His Majefty to " reftrain the carrying Coaftwife of Salt-petre, " Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms or Ammu-" nition." And the Lords Commissioners of His Majefty's Treasury, the Commissioners for Executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Master-General of the Ordnance, and His Majeffy's Secre-tary at War, are to give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may respectively appertain.
