ACCOUNTS are this Day received, that the Emperor of Morocco has declared War against the Dey of Algiers, for not assisting him, (as the Declaration sets forth) by attacking Oran according to Promise.

The King has been pleased to appoint Robert Duff, Esq; Rear-Admiral of the Blue, to be Governor and Commander in Chief in and over His Majesty's Island of Newfoundland in America, and of the Islands of Madelaine in the Gulph of St. Lawrence.
