By Letters lately received from Vice-Admiral Young, dated at Antigua the 3d of March, and from Vice-Admiral Gayton, dated at Jamaica the 28th of that Month, it likewise appears, That the Cruizers under the Command of the Former had seized Twenty-six, and those under the Command of the Latter Nine Ships and Vessels, either belonging to or employed in carrying on a Trade with His Majesty's Rebellious Subjects in North America.

Berlin, May 28. His Prussian Majesty returned immediately after the Review on Thursday last to Potzdam: On Saturday his Majesty went to Magdebourg, and is expected this Day or Tomorrow at Sans Souci.

Her Prussian Majesty on Sunday last received the Compliments of the Nobility and Foreign Ministers, and appears to be perfectly recovered from her late Indisposition.

Their Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess Ferdinand of Prussia, with their Household, removed on Saturday last to Frederichsfeldt.

Ritzebüttel, May 31. The Second Division of the Hessian Troops in His Britannick Majesty's Service arrived To-Day in this Neighbourhood. The Embarkation of the Second Division of the Brunswick Troops was completed Yesterday at Stade; and the Waldeck Regiment also embarked the same Evening at Bremerlehe.

St. James's, June 8, 1776.

Whereas it has been humbly represented to the King, That, on the 25th Day of December last past, between the Hours of Eleven and Twelve o'Clock at Night, divers Persons armed with Guns entered a Wood called *Nioffimes*, within the Parishes of *Iteringham* and *Saxthorpe* in the County of *Norfolk*, being the Property, and in the Occupation, of The Right Honourable the Lord *Walpole*; whose Gamekeeper, being alarmed at their shooting the Pheasants, went with some Assistants to enquire who those Persons were, when one of them immediately, without speaking a Word, levelled his Gun, and wounded the said Gamekeeper in the Left Thigh: His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Perpetrator of so cruel and atrocious an Act, is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any of the Accomplices in the same, who shall discover the Person who actually wounded the said Gamekeeper as aforesaid, so that he may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
