Plymouth, July 8. This Afternoon the Experiment, with the Ships and Veſſels under her Convoy, failed out of the Sound.

Port-moutb, July 9. Yeſterday the *Brſtol*, with her Convoy, failed from *St. Helen's* for *New York*.

Peterſburg, June 17. On Sunday laſt, being the Feſtival of the *Imailowsky Regiment* of Guards, the Empreſs came to Town, when there was a numerous Court; and the Officers of the ſaid Regiment had the Honour of Dining with her Imperial Maſteſty, a-uſuſil.

Early Yeſterday Morning the King of Sweden, under the Title of Count of Gothland, arrived in a Galley at *Cronſtadt*, attended by the Count Scheſter and Poſſi, General Troſe who commanded the Galley, two Chamberlains and a Secretary; and landing at *Oranienbaum*, proceeded with Baron *Nolken* to *Peterſburg*, where he did Count *Panio* the Honour of a Viſit, and afterwards dined at Baron *Nolken's* with Count *Panio*, who ſet out immediately after Dinner for *Zarſco Zelo* to announce the Count of Gothland, whom Baron *Nolken* attended thither. The Empreſs received her illuſtrious Viſitor with every Mark of Friendſhip; and preſented the Great Duke and Ducheis to him. After going to the Play and ſupping with her Imperial Maſteſty, the Count returned to Town and lodged at Baron *Nolken's*.

To-day the Count of Gothland dines with her Imperial Maſteſty at a Palace called the *Grenouillere*, about ſeven Werſts from hence. The Count will lodge To-night at Baron *Nolken's*, and will go Tomorrow to *Zarſco Zelo*, where he propoſes to remain till Saturday, when the Count removes to *Peterhoff*, at which Palace Apartments are prepared for him.

Dreſden, July 2. On Saturday Night laſt their Electoral Highneſſes returned to this City with Prince Anthony and Prince Maximilian, from the Camp at *Michen*; and on Sunday Night went, as uſuſil, to *Pillnitz* for the Week.
