Turin, July 1.

FRIDAY last being the Anniversary of his Majesty the King of Sardinia's Birth day, the same was observed with the usual Ceremonies.

Berlin, July 14. On the 7th in the Evening a large Party of Austrian Hussars having advanced on some Prussian Foragers, the King ordered three Squadrons of General Zieten's Hussars, under the Command of Major Probst, to attack them; which they did with great Success, having killed a considerable Number of the Enemy, and made three Officers and forty private Men Prisoners. The Prussians had only two Hussars killed, and two Officers dangerously wounded. The Austrians are said to be in Force at Jaromirz, about a German Mile and Half from the Prussian Fore-Posts.

By the last Accounts, of the 10th Instant, Prince Henry's Army was still in the Neighbourhood of Dresden.

Hague, July 20. Their Serene and Royal Highnesses the Prince and Princess of Orange set out for Loo, this Morning, for the Remainder of the Summer.

*W*HEREAS it has been humbly represented to the King, That, on Friday Night the 11th of this Month, between the Hours of Nine and Ten of the Clock, Richard Tookey, Keeper to the Right Honourable Lord Sondes of his Park called Rockingham Park in the County of Northampton, being in Cottingham Field, about Twenty Yards without-side the said Park, looking for a Female Deer that had got out of the said Park, in order to drive such Deer back again, was fired at and shot by some Person or Persons at present unknown, and one Ball went through or cross his Back, the other Ball broke his Jaw-bone, and otherwise shattered the same; and it being at present uncertain whether the said Richard Tookey can recover of the Wounds he so received, and there being Three Men in Company together: His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in shooting at the said Richard Tookey, is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any one of them, (except the Person who actually fired the said Gun) who shall discover his Accomplices therein, so that he or they may be apprehended and convicted thereof.

And, as a farther Encouragement, I the said Lord Sondes do hereby promise to pay the Sum of FIFTY POUNDS to the Person who shall make such Discovery as aforesaid, (except as before excepted) to be paid on the Conviction of the Offenders, or any one of them.
