A PROCLAMATION, For granting the Distribution of Prizes during the prefent Hostilities.

GEORGE R.

HEREAS, by Our Order in Council dated the Twenty-ninth Day of July laft, we have ordered, That ge neral Reprifals be granted agai. It the Ships, Goods and Subjects of the French King; and that as well Our Fleets and Ships, as alto all other Ships and Veffels that shall be commissionated by Letters of Marque, or general Repritals, or otherwife, by Our Commiffioners for executing Our Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, thall and may lawfully feize all Ships, Veffels and Goods, belonging to the French King, and bring the fame to Judgement in any of Our Courts of Admiralty within Our Dominions: We, being de-firous to give due Encouragement to all Our faithfirous to give due Encouragement to all Our faitn-ful Subjects who fhall lawfully feize the fame; and having declared in Council, by Our Order of the Seventh of laft Month, Our Intentions concerning the Diffribution of all Manner of Captures, Sei zures, Prizes and Reprifals, of all Ships and Goods, during the prefent Hoftilities, do now make known to all Our loving Subjects and all others whom it may concern, by this Our Proclamation, by and with the Advice of Our Privy Counci. by and with the Advice of Our Privy Counci., that Our Will and Pleature is, That the Neat Produce of all Prizes taken, the Right whereot is inherent in Us and Our Crown, be given o the Takers in the Proportion and Manner of Pro ceeding herein after for the: That is to fay, That all Prizes taken by Ships and Vessels hav-ing Commissions of Letters of Marque and Reprifals, may be fold and disposed of by the Merchants, Owners, Fitters, and others to whom fuch Letters of Marque and Repritals are granted, for their own Use and Benefit, after final Adjudication, and not before. And We do hereby further Order and direct, 1 hat the Neat Produce of all Prizes which are or shall be taken by any of Our Ships or Vef-fels of War, shall be for the entire Benefit and Encouragement of Our Flag Onicers, Captains, Commanders, and other Commissioned Officers in Our Pay, and of the Seamen, Marines, and Soldiers, on Board Our faid Ships and Veffels at the Time of the Capture ; and that fuch Prizes may be lawfully fold and disposed of by them and their Agents, after the fame shall have been to Us finally adjudged lawful Prize, and not otherwife. The Distribution fhail be made as follows; the Whole of the Neat Produce being first divided into Eight equal Parts :

The Captain or Captains of any of Our faid Ships and Veffels of War, who shall be actually on Board at the Taking of any Prize, shall

have Three Eighth Parts; but in cafe any fuch Prize shall be taken by any of Our Ships or Vessel of War, under the Command of a Flag or Flags, the Flag Officer or Officers being actual y on Board, or directing and affisting in the capture, shall have One of the faid Three Eighth Parts; the faid One Eighth Part to be paid to such Flag or Flag Officers in such Proportions, and subject to such Regulations, as are herein-after mentioned :

- The Captains of Marines and Land Forces, Sea Lieutenants, and Mafter on Board, fhall have One Lighth Part, to be equally divided amongst them:
- The Lieutenants and Quarter Mafters of Marines, and Lieutenants, Enfigns, and Quarter Mafters of Land Forces, Secretaries of Admirals or of Commodores, with Captains under them, Boatfwains, Gunners, Purfer, Carpenter, Mafter's Mates, Chirurgeon, Pilot, and Chaplain on Board, fhall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongft them :
- The Midshipmen, Captain's Clerk, Master Sailmaker, Carpenter's Mates, Boatswain's Mates, Gunner's Mates, Master at Arms, Corporals, Yeomen of the Sheets, Cockswain, Quarter Masters, Quarter Masters Mates, Chirurgeon's Mates, Yeomen of the Powder Room, Serjeants of Marines, and Land Forces on Board, shall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongs them :
- The Trumpeters, Quarter Gunners, Carpenter's Crew, Stewards, Cook, Armourer, Steward's Mate, Cook's Mate, Gunfmith, Cooper, Swabber, Ordinary Frumpeter, Barber, Able-Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and Marines, and other Soldiers, and all other Perfons doing Duty and affifting on Board, fhall have Two Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them:

Provided, That if any Officer being on Board any of Our Ships of War, at the Time of taking any Prize, fhall have more Commiffions or Offices than One, fuch Officer fhall be intitled only to the Share or Shares of the Prices which, according to the above mentioned Diftribution, fhall belong to his fuperior Commiffion or Office. And We do hereby frictly enjoin all Commanders of Our Ships and Veffels of War taking any Prize, as foon as may be, to transmit, or caufe to be transmitted, to the Commiffioners of Our Navy, a true Lift of the Names of all the Officers, Seamen, Marines, Soldiers, and others, who were actually on Board Our Ships and Veffels of War under their Command at the Time of the Capture ; which Lift fhall contain the Quality of the Service of each Perfon on Board, and be fubscribed by the Captain or Commanding Officer, and Three or more of the Chief Officers
