1783, P E. R S E N Т, The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREAS by an Act of Parliament passed this Session, intituled, "An Act "for preventing certain Instruments " from being required from Ships be-longing to the United States of America, and " to give to His Majelly, for a limited Time, " certain Powers for the better carrying on Trade " and Commerce between the Subjects of His Ma-" jefty's Dominions and the Inhabitants of the faid " United States," it is amongft other Things enacted, That during the Continuance of the faid Act, it shall and may be lawful for His Majesty in Council, by Order or Orders to be iffued and published from Time to Time, to give fuch Directions and to make fuch Regulations with respect to Duties, Drawbacks or otherwife, for carrying on the Trade and Com-merce between the People and Territories belonging to the Crown of Great Britain, and the People and Territories of the faid United States, as to His Majetty in Council thall appear molt expedient and falutary, any Law, Ulage or Cultom to the contrary notwithstanding: His Majesty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order and direct, That Pitch, Tar, Turpentine, Hemp, and Flax, Mafts, Yards, and Bowfprits, Staves, Heading, Boards, Timber, Shingles and all other Species of Lumber; Herfes, Neat Caule, Sheep, Hogs, Poultry, and all other Species of Live Stock and Live Provisions; Peas, Beans, Potatoes, Wheat, Flour, Bread, Biscuit, Rice, Oats, Barley, and all other Species of Grain, being the Growth or Production of any of the United States of America, m y (until further Order) be imported by British pubjects in British built Ships, owned by His Majefty's Subject, and navigated according to Law, from any Port of the United States of America, to any of His Majefty's Welt India Islands; and that Rum, Sugar, Melasses, Coffee, Cocha Nutts, Gin ger, and Pimento, may, until further O der, be exported by British Subjects, in British built Ships, owned by His Maj fty's Subjects, and navigated according to Law, from any of His Majefty's Weft India Island, to any Port or Place within the faid United States, upon Payment of the fame Duties on Exportation, and fubject to the like Rules, Regulations Securit.es and Rettrictions, as the fame Articles by Law are or may be fubject and liable to, if exported to any B it fh Colony or Plantation in America:-And the Right Honourable the Lords [Price Seven-Pence.]

Pieces; One Pair of Chafed Gadroon Siver Salts on Three Feet; One Silver Pint Mug; Four Silver Table Spoons marked GP1; Nine Silver Tea Spoons, and One Pair of Sugar Tongs; One Silver Pepper Caftor; Firste Silver Cruet and Caftor Tops; Three Silver old fashioned Wine Labels, Port, Mountain, and White Wine; One Plated Hand Candliflick, with a Creft thereon, wiz. a Swan creft, ijuing out of a Ducal Coronet; the fame Creft was on Five of the Tea Spoons, and on Part of the above Plate.

His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in breaking open and robbing the Dwelling-boufe as above-mentioned, is bereby pleafed to promife His most Gracious Pardon to any one of them, who shall discover bis, her or their Accomplice or Accomplices in the Said Crimes, fo that he, the or they may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
