HUNDRED POUNDS, and shall fuffer Impri-fonment in the Common Goal of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convicted, for Twelve Calendar Months, and until Foreiture be paid : And in Cafe of a subsequent Offence of the fame Kind, the Perfons fo again offending shall forfeit, for every Person contracted with or feduced, ONE THOUSAND POUNDS, and shall suffer Imprisonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convicted, for Two Years, and until fuch Forfeiture be paid.

If any Perfon in Great Britain or Ireland shall put on Board any Ship or Boat not bound directly to fome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, any fuch Tools or Utenfils as are commonly uled in, or proper for the Preparing, Working up or Mnishing of the Woollen or Silk Manufacturers' or any Part of fuch Tools, he shall for every Offence forfeit all fuch Tools, or Parts thereof, put on Board, and TWO HUNDRED POUNDS, to be recovered by Action of Debt, &c. in any Court of Record at Weftminster, or in the Court of Seffion in Scotland, or at any of the Four Courts, in Dublin respectively, wherein no Effoin, &c. fhall be allowed.

It shall be lawful for any Officer of the Customs in Great Britain, or for any Officer of the Revenue in Ireland, to feize and fecure, in fome of His Majesty's Warehouses, all fuch Tools or Utenfils prohibited to be exported, as fuch Officer shall find on Board any Veffel not bound directly to fome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain; and all Tools fo feized fhall, after Condemnation,' be pub-lickly fold to the beft Bidder; and one Moiety of the Froduce fhall be to the Ufe of His Majefty, and the other Moiety to the Officer who shall feize and fecure the fame.

If the Captain of any Veffel in Great Britain or Ireland knowingly permit any of the faid Tools, prohibited to be exported, to be put on Board his Vessel, he shall for every such Offence forfeit ONE HUNDRED POUNDS, to be recovered as the Penalties inflicted upon Persons exporting the Tools; and if the Vessel belongs to His Majesty, the Captain shall not only forfeit ONE HUN-DRED POUNDS, but thall also forfeit his Employment, and be incapable of any Employment under His Majefty.

If any Officer of the Cuftoms in Great Britain, or of the Revenue in Ireland, take, or knowingly fuffer to be taken, any Entry outward, or fign any Cocket or Sufferance for the Shipping or Exporting of any of the faid Tools, or knowingly fuffer the fame to be done, he shall forfeit ONE HUNDRED POUNDS, to be recovered as aforefaid, and alfo forfeit his Office, and be incapable of any.Office under His Majesty.

One Moiety of the Forfeitures shall be applied to the Use of His Majesty, and the other Monety to the Ufe of the Perfon who shall fue for the fame.
