A S feweral Artificers and Manufacturers, Subjects of Great Britain, bave from Time to Time gone of Great Britain, have from Lime to Lime gone into Foreign Countries to exercise their several Callings, contrary to the Laws of These Kingdoms; The following Abstracts of Two Acts of Parliament of George the First and George the Second; to prevent such Practices, are published for the Information of all Persons who may be ignorant of the Penalities they may incur by Dichedience to them — And it owill be observed, that Disobedience to them.-And it will be objerved, that they extend to those who are any ways concerned or infrumental in the Sending or Enticing Artificers or Ma-nufacturers out of these Kingdoms, and in the Export ation of the Tools and Infruments used by them, as well as to the Artificers or Manufacturers themfelves.

Statute 5 George I. Chap. 27.

TF any Person shall contract with, entice, or folicit, any Artificer in Wool, Iron, Steel, Brass, or other Metal, Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other Artificer of Great Britain, to go into Foreign Countries, out of the King's Dominions, and fhall be convicted thereof upon Indictment or Informa-tion, in any of the Courts at Weftminster, or at the Affizes or Quarter-Seffions, he shall be fined any Sum not exceeding ONE HUNDRED POUNDS or the first Offence, and shall be imprifoned Three Months, and till the Fine be paid. And if any Per-fon having been once convict, shall offend again, he shall be fined at the Diferetion of the Court, and imprisoned Twelve Month's, and till the Fine be paid. If any of the King's Subjects, being fuch Artificers, shall go into any Country out of His Ma-

jefty's Dominions, to exercise or teach the faid Trades to Foreigners; and if any of the King's Subjects in any such Foreign Country, exercising any of the faid Trades, shall not return into this Realm within Six Months after Warning given by the Ambaffador, Minister or Conful of Great Britain, in the Country where fuch Artificers shall be, or by any Perfon authorised by fuch Ambassador, &c. or by one of the Secretaries of State, and from thenceforth inhabit within this Realm ; fuch Perfon shall be incapable of taking any Legacy, or of being an Executor or Administrator, and of taking any Lands, &c. within this Kingdom, by Defcent, De-vife or Purchafe; and shall forfeit all Lands, Goods, &c. within this Kingdom, to His Majefty's Use, and shall be deemed Alien, and out of His

Majefty's Protection. Upon Complaint made upon Oath before any Juffice of Peace that any Perfon is endeavouring to feduce any fuch Artificer, or that any fuch Artificer hath contracted, or is preparing to go out of His Majelly's Dominions, for the Purpoles afore-faid; fuch Jultice may fend his Warrant to bring the Person complained of before him, or before fome other Justice; and if it shall appear by the Oath of one Witness, or by Confession, that he was guilty of any of the faid Offences, fuch Juftice may bind him to appear at the next Affizes or Quarter Sef-fions : And if fuch Perfon fhall refufe to give Security, the Justice may commit him to Goal till the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions, and until he fhall. be delivered by due Courfe of Law. And if any

beyond the Seas for the Purpole aforelaid, he shall give fuch Security to the King, not to depart out of His Majefly's Dominions, as fuch Court shall think reafonable, and shall be imprisoned till Security given.

If any of the above Offences shall be committed in Scotland the fame shall be profecuted in the Court of Jufficiary, or the Circuits there.

Statute 23 George II. Chap. 13.

IF any Perfon shall contract with, or endeavour to feduce any Artificer in Wool, Mohair, Cot-ton or Silk, or in Iron, Steel, Brass, or other Metal, or any Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other Artificer in any other of the Manufactures of Great Britain or Ireland, to go out of this Kingdom or Ireland, into any Foreign Country, not within the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, and shall be convicted upon Indictment or Information in the King's Bench at Westminster, or by Indictment at the Assistant at General Gaol Delivery for the County, &c. wherein such Offence shall be committed in England, or by Indictment in the Court of Jufticiary, or any of the Circuit Courts in Scotland, or by Indictment or Information in the King's Bench at Dublin, if fuch Offence be committed in Ireland; the Perfon fo convicted shall, for every Ar-tificer contracted with, or feduced, forfeit. FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS, and shall suffer Impri-fonment in the Common Goal of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convicted, for Twelve Calendar Months, and until Foreiture be paid : And in Cale of a fublequent Offence of fame Kind, the Perfons fo again offending the fhall forfeit, for every Person contracted with or feduced, ONE THOUSAND POUNDS, and thall fuffer Imprisonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender thall be convicted, for Two Years, and until fuch Forfeiture be paid.

If any Perfon in Great Britain or Ireland shall put on Board any Ship or Boat. not bound directly to fome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome tome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Bri-tain, any fuch Tools or Utenfils as are commonly ufed in, or proper for the Preparing, Working up or Finishing of the Woollen or Silk Manufacturers or any Part of fuch Tools, he shall for every Of-fence forfeit all fuch Tools, or Parts thereof, put on Board, and TWO HUNDRED POUNDS, to on Board, and I we include the recorder, to be recovered by Action of Debt, &c. in any Court of Record at Weltminiter, or in the Court of Seffion in Scotland, or at any of the Four Courts, in Dublin respectively, wherein no Effoin, sec. fhall be allowed.

It shall be lawful for any Officer of the Customs in Great Britain, or for any Officer of the Revenue in Ireland, to feize and fecure, in fome of His Ma-jefty's Warehouses, all such Tools or Utensils prohibited to be exported, as fuch Officer shall find on goard any Veffel not bound directly to fome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain; and all Tools fo feized shall, after Condemnation, be pubfuch Artificer shall be convicted upon Indictment of lickly fold to the best Bidder; and one Moiety of aby such Promise, Contract, or Preparation to go the Produce shall be to the Use of His Majesty. lickly fold to the best Bidder; and one Moiety of and
