

Berlin, May 22.

The King arrived here from Potsdam, on the 19th, and the Day following the Reviews began, in which His Majesty commanded in Person. The Troops made a remarkably fine Appearance, and performed the different Evolutions with the greatest Precision.

Paris, May 27.

On Friday last, the 25th Instant, His Most Christian Majesty went in State to the Assembly of the Notables, when, after Speeches having been delivered by the King, Monsieur, the King's Brother, and several of the Great Officers of State, and principal Members, that Assembly was finally closed. After which they proceeded to Versailles, to return His Most Christian Majesty. Thanks for his gracious Condescension in having called them together.

WHEREAS it has been humbly represented to the King, that in the Morning of the 10th Instant, about One o'Clock, a Fire broke out in the Dwelling-house of Mr. James Falk, of Happisburgh in the County of Norfolk, Farmer, which in a short Time entirely consumed the same, together with the Barn, Stable and Out-Houses adjoining, and with all the Furniture, Corn and Implements of Husbandry therein; and that from several Circumstances, particularly from the Horses, which were carefully tied up in the Stable, and the Door locked the preceding Evening, being found at large in the Morning, it is greatly suspected that the said Fire was not accidental, but occasioned by some malicious Person or Persons unknown: His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in this atrocious Offence, is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any one of the Offenders, (except the Person who actually set Fire to the said House, Barn, Stable and Out-Houses) who shall discover his Accomplice or Accomplices therein, so that he or they may be apprehended and convicted thereof.

And, as a further Encouragement, a Reward of FIFTY POUNDS is hereby offered to any Person making such Discovery as above-mentioned, (except as above excepted) to be paid upon the Conviction of any one of the Offenders, by the said Mr. James Falk, of Happisburgh.

Whitehall, May 25, 1787.

WHEREAS it has been humbly represented to the King, that in the Morning of the 14th Instant, a Smuggling Cutter belonging to Looe, in Cornwall, John Clements, Master, was taken by the Crew of a Boat belonging to His Majesty's Cutter the Pigmy, in Cemas Bay, in the Isle of Anglesea, after a Skirmish in which a Seaman on Board the said Boat was killed, and that the Captain of the Cutter and Six Men made their Escape.

His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the said Murder, is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any one of the Persons who were on Board the

said Smuggling Cutter, (except the Person or Persons who actually committed the said Murder) who will discover his Accomplices therein, so that they or any of them may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
