Dublin Castle, November 17, 1787.

THE Remains of his Grace Charles Duke of Rutland, late Lord Lieutenant General and General Governor of this Kingdom, having been removed, in the Night of the 13th Instant, from His Majesty's Lodge in the Phoenix Park, to the Great Committee Room of the House of Lords, which, together with the adjacent Chambers, had been previously prepared for their Reception, they were there laid in State, attended by the Officers of his Grace's Household, with the Battle Axe Guards, and a proper Guard of Infantry.

At Eleven o'Clock this Day the Body was conveyed to the Funeral Chariot, at the Great Portico of the Parliament House, preceded by the Choirs of the several Cathedrals singing a Funeral Dirge. The Procession from thence was conducted in the following Order.
