*Whitehall, March 27.*

**T**HE King has been pleased to grant to Walter Hill, of Milford, in the County of Stafford, Esq; Lieutenant in His Majesty's Navy, and his Issue by Mary Catherine his Wife, Daughter and only Child of Edward Coyney, late of Alton Lodge, in the County of Stafford, Esq; deceased, His Royal Licence and Authority to assume and use the Surname and bear the Arms of Coyney, in Addition to those of Hill, pursuant to the last Will and Testament of the said Edward Coyney; such Arms being first duly exemplified, according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds Office; and also to order that this His Majesty's Concession and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms.
