HIS Day the Lords being met, a Meffage was fent to the Honourable Houfe of Commons by Sir Francis Molyneux, Gentleman Ufher of the Black Rod, acquainting them, that The Lords, authorized by virtue of His Majefty's Commiffion, for declaring His Royal Affent to feveral Acts agreed upon by both Houfes, do defire the immediate Attendance of this Honourable Houfe in the Houfe of Peers, to bear the Commiffion read; and the Commons being come thither, the faid Commiffion, impowering the Lord Archbiffiop of Canterbury, the Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and the Lord Kenyon, to dealare and notify the Royal Affent to the faid Acts, was read accordingly, and the Royal Affent given to

An Act to enable the Company of Proprietors of the Thames and Severn Canal Navigation to borrow a further Sum of Money to compleat the faid Navigation.

An AEI for making and maintaining a navigable Canal from Manchefter to or near Prefto-lee-Bridge, in the Township of Little Lever, and from thence, by One Branch, to or near the Town of Bolton, and, by another Branch, to or near the Town of Bury, and to Weddell Brook, in the Parish of Bury, all in the Sounty Palatine of Lancoller.

County Palatine of Lantoster. An AA for making and maintaining a navigable Canal from Kington in the County of Hereford, by or through Leominster, to join the River Severn, near Stourport Bridge, in the County of Worcester.

An AA for making and maintaining a navigable Communication between the Loughborough Ganal and the Town of Leicefter; and for making and maintaining a Communication by Kail Ways or Stone Roads and Water Levels, from feveral Places and Mines, to the faid Loughborough Canal; and for continuing the fame, by paffing along the faid Canal, to the faid mavigable Communication, all in the County of Leicofter.

An Act for repairing, paving and cleanfing the Highways, Streets and I anes within the Town and Borough of Deal in the County of Kent, and for re-

moving and preventing Encroachments, Obstructions, Nuifancei and Annoyauces therein.

An AA for lighting, cleanfing and watching the Streets, Lanes and other Public Paffages and Placet, within the Township of Stourbridge, in the Parish of Old Swinford, in the County of Worcester; and for removing and preventing Officiations, Nuifances and Annoyances therein.

An Act for building a new Common Gaol and Seffion House, with Accommodations thereto, for the County of Surrey; and for disposing of the present County Gaol and the Ground thereto belonging.

An Act for taking down and rebuilding the Parifle Church of All Saints, within the Town and County of the Town of Southampton; and for purchafing Land for the Purpose of a Church yard, for the Use of the faid Parifle.

An All for the better Relief and Employment of the Poor within the Hundreds of Loes and Wilford in the County of Suffolk.

An Act for opening a new Road from Milford in the County of Pembroke to Stainton, and for amending and nuidening the Road from the faid new Road, through Stainton and Johnson, to Merlin's Bridge, in the fame County.

An Att to continue the Term and Powers of an Att, paffed in the Tenth Year of the Reign of His prefent' Majefty King George the Ibird, for repairing and widening the Road from Lewes to Brighthelmflon in the County of Suffex.

An Act for amending, swidening and keeping in Repair the Road leading from the Alceller and Enefham Turnpike Road, at the End of Wixford Lane in the County of Warwick. to Chipping Campden, and from thence to Upton Old Lane in the County of Glaucefter.

An AE to continue and amend an AE of the Twelfth Year of the Reign of East prefent Majefty, for repairing and widening the Read from the Exeter Turnpike at Reedy Gate, in the Parish of Dunoford, in the County of Dewon, to Cherrybrook, in the Forest of Darimoore, in the faid County-

Dartmoore, in the faid County. An Aft for enlarging the Term and Powers of hn Aft, paffed in the Ienth Vear of the Reign of His prefent Majefly, for repairing and widening the Roads leading from Brighthelmston to the County Oak on Level Heath in the County of Suffex. An
