in, and the Cone of the Velcano is lowered Four or Five Hundred Feet, the present Crater being enlarged and nearly upon a Level with the Top of the Mountain of Somma. The Afhes that were carried up, with a Column of Water and Smoke to the perpen-dicular Height of Four Miles, have fallen and done anfinite Mifchief to the Town, Villages and Country at the Foot of that Mountain, throwing down fome Houses and beating in the Roofs of many. Several Families from Torre del Greco are still missing, but it is believed that very few Lives have been lolt. The Lava, that ran over the greatest Part of that Town in it's Way to the Sea, where it has raifed a Promontory, is in fome Places Seventy Feet high, and it's Breadth about a Quarter of a Mile. The Whole of it's Courfe may be about Four Miles, which it performed in lefs than Four Hours.
