

A^T the Court at St. James's, the 12th of November, 1794,

PRE SENT, The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. HEREAS by an Act of Parliament passed in the Twenty-fixth Year of His late Majesty's Reign, intituled, " An Act to oblige Ships more effectually to perform their Quarantine, " and for the better preventing the Plague being " brought from Foreign Parts into Great Britain " or Ireland, or the Islands of Guernsey, Jersey, " Alderney, Sark or Man," it is, among many other Things, enacted, That all Ships and Veffels arriving, and all Persons, Goods and Merchandizes whatfoever, coming or imported into any Port or Place within Great Britain, or any of the Ifles beforementioned, from any Place from whence His Majefty, His Heirs or Succeflors, by and with the Advice of His or Their Privy Council, shall judge it probable that the Infection may be brought, shall be obliged to make their Quarantine in fuch Place and Places, for fuch Time, and in fuch Manner, as has been or shall, from Time to Time, be directed by His Majesty, His Heirs or Succeffors, by His or Their Order or Orders, made in His or Their Privy Council, and notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette; and that until fuch Ships, Veffels, Perfons, Goods and Merchandizes shall have respectively performed and be discharged from such Quarantine, no fuch Perfon, Goods or Merchandizes, or any of them, shall come or be brought on Shore, or

go or be put on board any other Ship or Veffel, in any Place within His Majesty's Dominions. unleis in fuch Manner, and in fuch Cafes, and by fuch Licence, as shall be directed or permitted by fuch Order or Orders made by His Majefty, His Heirs or Successors, in Council as aforefaid; and that all fuch Ships and Veffels, and the Perfons or Goods coming or imported in, or going or being put on board the fame, and all Ships, Veffels, Boats and Perfons receiving any Goods or Perfons out of the fame, shall be subject to such Orders, Rules and Directions concerning Quarantine, and the Prevention of Infection, as have been or shall be made by His Majefty, His Heirs and Succeffors, in Council, and notified by Proclamation or published in the London Gazette as aforementioned, under fuch Pains and Penalties as are inflicted by the faid Act.

And whereas Information has been received that a Fever, which is fimilar in it's Symptoms and Mortality to the malignant and contagious Fever, of the Nature of the Plague, which prevailed laft Year in Philadelphia, in the State of Penfylvania, has manifested itself at Baltimore in the State of Maryland; His Majesty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, judging it probable that the Infection may be brought into this Kingdom from Baltimore, or fome other Port or Place in the faid State of Maryland, doth thereupon deem it expedient, for the Safety of the Publick Health, to order, and it is hereby ordered, That all Ships, Vessels, Perfons, Goods and Merchandize now ar-

rived,
