Day each Ship or Vessel shall come to Anchor in the Place appointed for the Performance of Quarantine, and not before.

That the Places herein after named shall be and are hereby appointed to be the Places wherein such Ships or Vessels (not having the Infection on board) shall respectively perform Quarantine; that is to fay: All Ships or Vefiels which are or shall be bound to the Port of London, or any Member, Creek, or other Parts thereof, or to the River Thames or Medway, shall perform their Quarantine in Standgate Creek; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Ipswich, Yarmouth, Lynn, Boston, Hull, Newcastle or Berwick upon Tweed, or any of them, or any Member or Creek thercof, or other Place therein, shall perform their Quarantine in Whitebooth Road, between Hull and Grimfby; all Ships or Vesfels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Carlifle and Chester, or either of them, or any Memler or Creek thereof, or other Place therein, or to any l'art of the Isle of Man, shall perform their Quarantine in a Place called Highlake, near Liverpool, at the Well End thereof; all Ships or Vocals which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Milford, Cardiff, Gleucester, Briftol, Bridgwater, or any of them, or any Member or Creek of them, or any of them, or to PadRow or St. Ive's, being Members of the Port of Plymouth, or to Ilfracombe or Barnsaple, being Members of the Port of Exeter, or to any other Place within the faid Ports of Milio d, Cardiff, Gloucester, Bristol or ! Bridgwater, or within the faid Members or Creeks, shall perform their Quarantine in Kingroad and fuch Pa :, thereof as have been herein before mentioned, or to the Port of Exeter, except fuch Parts thereof as have been herein before mentioned, or to the Past of Pool, or any of the Members or Creeks or other Flaces within the faid Ports of Plymouth, Exceer and Rool, except as before excepted, or to Falm add, a Member of the Port of Plymouth, or any Creek thereof, or any other Flace therein, shall perform their Quarantine in a Place called St. Ive's Pool, within the Mouth of the Harbour of Falmouth; all Ships or Veffels which are or shall be bound to the Poits of Southampton, Chichefter, Sandwich, or any of them, or any of the Members or Crocks thereof, or of any of them, or any other Place within the same, shall perform their Quarantine at a Place called the Mother Bank, near Portfmouth; all Ships or Veffels which are or Grograin or Mohair Yarn, Human Hair, Goats shall be bound to the Eastern Coast of Scotland. comprehending the Parts of Leith, Borrowstoness, Alloa Dunbar, Kirkaldy, Anstruther, Preston-Pans, Dundee, Perth, Montrole and Aberdeen, or to an Member, Creek or other Parts thercof, shall per-

form their Quantities in Inverkeithing Bay; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Western Ports of Scotland, comprehending the Ports of Port Glesgow, Greenock, Irvine, Campbeltoun, Oban, Rothfay, Fort William, Air, Port Patrick, Strangacr and Wigtoun, or to any Member, Creek or other Parts thereof, shall perform their Quarantine at Lamlash in the Island of Arran; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Northern Ports of Scotland, comprehending the Ports of Inverness, Zetland, Orkney, Caithness and Stornaway, or to any Member, Creek or other Parts thereof, shall perform their Quarantine in Cromarty Bay in the Murray Firth; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the South-West Ports of Scotland, comprehending the Ports of Dumfries and Kirkcudbright, or to any Member, Creek or other Parts thereof, shall perform their Quarantine at Carsthorn, at the Mouth of the River Nith; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Isle of Jersey, or any Part thereof, shall perform their Quarantine at a certain Place on the Coast of the faid Island, called Belle-Croute, or at some Place herein before appointed for Performance of Quarantine on the Coast of England; and all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Islands of Guernfey, Sark or Alderney, or either of them, or any Part of them, or any of them, shall perform their Quarantine in a Place near the Island of Guernfey, called the Little Road, or at fome Place berein before appointed for Performance of Quarantine on the Coast of England.

That no Pilot faall go on board any Ship or Perfitate Pill; all Ships or Veffels which are or Veffel obliged to perform Quarantine, in order to shall be bound to the Port of Plymouth, except conduct the same into any Port or Place, but shall perform such Service in some other Boat or Veilel, which Boat or Vessel stall keep as much to the Windward of the Ship or Vessel so to be conducted as possible; and if any Pilot or other Person shall go on board fach Ship or Vesicl, such Pilot or other Person shall perform Quarantine, in like Manner as any Person coming in such Ship or Vessel shall be obliged to perform the same.

> That all Goods, Wares and Merchandizes liable to Quarantine as aforesaid, shall he opened, unpacked and aired, unless His Majesty shall think fit, by His Order in Council, to direct otherwise, and so remain a Week, other than Hemp and Flax, Paper or Books, Silk raw, thrown or wrought, Linen, Cotton-Wool, Cotton-Yarn or manufactured,. Wool raw or any wife wrought, Feathers, Hair, Carmenia Wool, Carpets, Camblets, Burdets, or other Manufactures of Silk and Cotton, Kid-Skins, and Skins in the Wool or Hair, Spunges, Vine and Oil in Chests, Thread Stockings, all Goods packed with Straw or Cotton, Straw Hats
