Ρ E ENT, R S The KING's Moft Excellent Majefty in Council. 7HEREAS by an Act, passed in this present Session of Parliament, intituled, " An Act "" for enabling His Majefty to prohibit the Exporta-." tion and permit the Importation of Corn, and of for allowing the Importation of other Articles of " Provision for a limited Time without Payment of ." Duty," it is enached, That from and after the paffing of the faid Act, and until the Expiration of Six Weeks from the Commencement of the next Seffion of Parliament, it shall and may be lawful · for His Majefty, His Heirs and Succeffors, and he and they is and are thereby authorized, with the Advice of His or Their Privy Council, whatever may be the general Average Price of Wheat, Rye, Bar ley, Buer or Bigg, Peafe, Beans, Oats or Oatmeal, in England or Scotland respectively, from Time to Time, when and as often as the fame shall be judged expedient, to prohibit generally, for a limited Time, the Exportation from England and Scotland refpectively of any British or Foreign Wheat, Rye, Barley, Beer or Bigg, Peafe, Beans, Oats, or any Meal or Flour, or Bread, Bifesit or Malt made thereof, or any Indian Corn or Maize, or Meal or Flour made thereof, and to permit generally the Importation into England or Scotland respectively of any Foreign Corn or other Articles as aforefaid, in any British Ship or Veffel, or in any other Ship or Veffel belonging to Perfons of any Kingdom or State in

Amity with His Majesty, and navigated in any Manner whatever, without Payment of any Daty whatfoever ; and also the taking out of Warehouse, for Home Confumption, of any fuch Foreign Corn or other Articles as aforefaid, without Payment of any Duty whatfoever; and in like Manner to recal fuch Prohibition or Permiffion, either in Part or in the Whole, if Circumstances shall appear fo to require, any Thing in an Act, passed in the 31st Year of His prefent Majefty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for regulating the Importation and Ex-" portation of Corn, and the Payment of the Duty . " on Foreign Corn imported, and of the Bounty on " British Corn exported," and another Act passed in the 33d Year of His prefent Majefty's Reign, for amending the aforefaid Act, or in any other Act, or Part of any Act, to the contrary notwithstanding, fubject, nevertheles, to the Provisoes therein mentioned, and herein after contained.

His Majefty thereupon, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, purfuant to the Powers given by the faid Act, paffed in this prefent Seffion of Parliament, has thought fit to order, and it is hereby ordered, that from and after the Date of this prefent Order, until the 30th Day of September next, no Perfon or Perfons whatfoever thall export, or fhall load or lay on Board any Ship or other Veffels with the Intent to export from any Port or Place of this Kingdom, any Wheat, Rye, Barley, Beer or Bigg, Peafe, Beans, Oats, Indian Corn or Maizes or any Meal or Flour, or Bread, Bifcuit or Malt made thereof.
