Daily Attendance will be given at the above Offices, till further Notice, from Ten o'Clock till Three.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE Notices, the Commissioners think it expedient to caution the Public, that every Person who, fince the 5th Day of May inflant, bas worn Hair Powder, IS LIABLE TO THE DUTY OF ONE GUINEA, and required to take out a flamped Certificate of that Value; at the Expiration of one Month from that Day, a PENALTY of Twenty Pounds will attach upon every Perfon who Jhall use and wear Hair Powder, without taking out a Certificate for the fame; and that if Informations are then tendered against Offenders, the Commissioners cannot, confistently with their Duty, refuse to receive them, and to direct Projecutions accordingly.

To prevent which, and that Perfons may be accommodated with the leaf. Inconvience and Delay, it is earnefly recommended to fuch as require-Certificates, to provide themselves there with immediately, by applying at such of the Offices above mentioned as are respectively appointed for Perfons refiding within these different Districts; and if the Parties applying could make it convenient, previously to furnish themselves with the Forms of Entry, which are iffued, gratis, at the faid Offices, and deliver them in properly filled up, it is prefumed that it would greatly facilitate the Business of taking out Certificates, by flortening the Time of Waiting, and preventing that Embarraffment, which, from the numerous Applications that may be expected to be made for them towards the Close of the Month, will otherwise unavoidably occur.
