#### Office for Auditing the Public Accounts, Somerset Place, January 13, 1796.

WHEREAS divers Perfons, to whom Money has been iffued for Public Services, have neglected to deliver into this Office the Vouchers for the Expendi-ture thereof, together with an Account Current, in the Manner and within the Time prefcribed by the ACT for better examining and Auditing the Public Accounts of this Kingdom, the Commissioners for Auditing the Public Accounts have directed that Copies of the following Sections of the faid Act be inferted in the London Gazette, in order that all Perfons to whom Public Money has been, or shall be, so iffued, may be informed of the Consequences of such Neglect.

SECTION XVII. And whereas great Losses and Inconveniencies have arisen to the Public, by Sub-Accountants not having been put in Charge till a long Time has elapfed after the Monies were iffued to them, be it enacted, That the Paymafter-General of His Majefty's Forces, the Treafurer of the Navy, the Treafurer of the Ordnance, and every other Public Officer who fhall hereafter pay into the Hands of any Perfon or Perfons whomfoever, Money for Public Services, by Way of Impreft or on Account, fhall, within Thirty Days of the 31ft Day of December, One thousand feven hundred and eighty-five, and within Thirty Days of the 31ft Day of December in every future Year; tranfmit an Account of all Sums of Money iffued or paid by him or them to any Perfon or Perfons, for the Public Service, within the preceding Year, to the Commissioners to be appointed under the Authority of this A&; who fhall, and they are hereby required forthwith to transmit Duplicates of the fame to His Majefty's Remembrancer in the Court of Exchequer, who fhall immediately, on Receipt of fuch Accounts put the fourier for the Receipt of fuch Accounts, put the feveral Sums fo iffued in Charge against the Parties, in like Man-ner as is now practified with respect to Persons who receive Money by Way of Impress, and on Ac-count, at the Receipt of His Majesty's Exchequer.

SECTION XVIII. Provided always, and be in enacted, That no Accountant shall be allowed it his Account any Sum which he shall issue or pay OVE
