unlefs by the express Permission of His Majesty, fignified under the Hand of One of, His Majefty's Principal Secretaries of State :- And His Majefty is hereby further pleafed to order, by and with the Advice aforefaid, that Notice of this Order shall be printed in different Languages, and shall be affixed in rublic Places in the different Ports of this Kingdom, and fhall alfo be delivered by the Cuflom-Houfe Officers to the Mafter of every fuch Ship; Vefiel or Boat arriving at any Port or Place in this Kingdom, execept as aforefaid, and to all Foreigners acriving in any fuch Ship, Veffel or Boat : Provided always, That this Order shall not extend to any Foreign Ambaffador, or other Public Minister duly authorized, or the Servants actually attendant upon any fuch Ambaffador or Public Minister, or any Alien Merchant, being fuch within the true Intent and Meaning of the faid Act of the Thirty-third Year of His Majefty's Reign, or any domeftic Servant of any natural-born Subject of His Majefty, or of any Subject to whom Letters of Denization have been or shall be hereafter granted, or any domestic Servant of any of His Majelty's Subjects who now are or shall hereafter be naturalized by Act of Parliament, fuch Servants refpectively being actually and bonâ fide employed in the Service of their refpective Mafters, and actually at the Time attendant upon their respective Masters ; nor to any Mariner, actually engaged and employed in the Navigation of any Ship or Veffel, during the Time that fuch Mariner shall remain to actually engaged and employed, and certified, in the Manner in the faid ASt mentioned, to be fuch Mariner, by the Mafter or Commander of fuch Ship or Vefiel upon his Arrival in any fuch Port or Place as aforefaid. And the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majefty's Treafury, the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty, and the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the necessary Directions herein as to them may refpectively appertain.
