Regiments and Inaïwiduals who cannot attend to receive Payment in Loudon, and the Heirs of deceased Perfons, will be paid on granting the proper Authorities, agreeable to the Forms required in the following Regulations, which are necessary to be so particular to guard against the Impositions attempted by frequent Forgeries of Powers of Attorney and Wills, for the fraudulent Purpose of receiving Prize-Money of Absentees and deceafed Persons (by those who are not legally entitled thereto) viz.

For a Regiment, One Power of Attorney to the proper Regimental Agent thereof, refiding in London, (who will fign the Prize Lifts) to be figned and fealed by each Individual, alive and prefent at the Time, for bimfelf only; and to be witneffed by the Commanding Officer and Paymaster, or Adjutant, of such Regiment;

who are to make Oath before a Magistrate, that they faw cash Individual, whole Name is fubfcribed thereunto, fign it for simjelf only, and that usne is ned the Name or Names of another or others, whether prefent, abjent, or deceased,

Serjeants, Corporals, Drummers and Private Soldiers, who may have been dijcharged, or are not p-just with the Regiment they. belong to, may grant Power of sttorney to the laid Agents, to be witheyed by a Clirg, an of the Parifb wherein they refids at the Time, and aljo by a Magifirate, before whom they are to make O.th (which is to appear on the jaid Power) that he or they is or are the identical Perfon or Perfons named therein, and that he or they are actually entitled to shore Prize Money for the Capture of the faid Iflands in 1794, or for fuch of them as they muy be entitlea to. The Heirs of deceased Officers and Serjeanss, or of Perfores paring in the fame Casses with them, cannot be paid without administering; but, after doing jo, they may receive either perforally, or b) Power of Astorney accompanying the Letter of Administration, The Heirs of deceased Corporals, Drummers, and Private Soldiers, are to make Oath before a Magistrate, thu he or they is or are the legal Heir or Heirs of the Perfon or Perjins whofs Prize Money he or they claim ; which Affidavit is to be produced to me, together with a Certificate, figned by a Clergyman and Church-Warden of the Purish wherein they refide, that they believe them to be the right deirs of the Perfon or Perfons whofe Prize Money they claim; upon which they may receive perfonally or by granting Powers of Actorney.

Regiments in Ireland, who have not Agents in Landon, may grant Powers of Attorney to any Regimental Agents in London.

All absent Officers can, of course, receive their Prize Money upon granting Powers of Attorney to their Regimental Agent:.

The greatest Part of the Prize Money for fuid Captures is not yet entirely extricated from Law Suits fo as to be quite ready for Diffribution, nor is the King's Grant yet obigined for it. The Moment it can be proceeded on, Notice thereof will be given to the Captors. Letters, Post-paid only, addressed to me as above, will be duly anfavered.
