AT the Court at St. James's, the 18th of Occober,

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. 7 HEREAS by an Act of Parliament passed in the Twenty-fixth Year of His late Majelly's Reign, intituled, " An Act to oblige Ships " more effectually to perform their Quarantine, " and for the better preventing the Plague being brought from Foreign Parts into Great Britain
or Ireland, or the Isles of Guernsey, Jersey,
Alderney, Sark or Man," it is, among many other Things, enacted, That all Ships and Ves-fels arriving, and all Persons, Goods and Merchandizes whatfoever, coming or imported into any Port or Place within Great Britain, or any of the Isles beforementioned, from any Place from whence His Majesty. His Heirs or Successors, by and with the Advice of Hisor Their Privy Council, shall judge it probable that the Infection may be brought, shall be obliged to make their Quarantine in fuch Place and Places, for such Time, and in such Manner, as has been or shall, from Time to Time, be directed by His Majelly, His Heirs or Successors, by His or their Order or Orders, made in His or Their Privy Council, and notified by Proclamation, or published in the London Gazette; and that until such Ships, Vessels, Persons, Goods and Merchandizes shall have respectively performed and be discharged from such Quarantine, no such Persons, Goods or Merchandizes, or any of them, shall come or be brought on Shore, or go or be put on board any other Ship or Vessel, in any Place within His Majesty's Dominions, unless in luch Manner, and in such Cases, and by fuch Licence, as shall be directed or permitted by fuch Order or Orders made by His Majesty, His Heirs-or Successors, in Council as aforelaid; and that all such Ships and Vessels, and the Persons or Goods coming or imported in, or going or being put on board the same, and all Ships, Vessels, Boats and Persons receiving any Goods or Persons out of the same, shall be subject to such Orders, Rules and Directions concerning Quarantine, and the Prevention of Infection, as have been or shall be made by His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, in Council, and notified by Proclamation or published in the London Gazette as aforementioned, under such Pains and Penalties as are inflicted be the faid Ac.

And whereas Information has been received that a malignant and infectious Difease of the Nature of the Plague, exists in the City of Philadelphia, in the State of Pensylvania, within the United States of America; His Majesty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, judging it probable that the faid Infection may be brought into this Kingdom from Philadelphia, doth thereupon deem It expedient, for the Safety of the Publick Health, to order, and it is hereby ordered, That all Ships, Vessels, Persons, Goods and Merchandizes now arrived, or that shall hereafter arrive in any Port of this Kingdom, or the Isles of Guernsey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark or Man, from Philadelphia, or any Port within the State of Penfylvania, do make their Quarantine for Fourteen Days, which is to commence and be computed from the Day each Ship or Vessel shall come to Anchor in the Place appointed for the Performance of Quarantine, and not before.

That the Places herein after named shall be and are hereby appointed to be the Places wherein fuch Ships or Veilels (not having the Infection on board) thall respectively perform Quarantine; that is to say: All Ships of Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Port of London, or any Member, Creek, or other Parts thereof, or to the River Thames or Medway, shall perform their Quarantine in Standgate Creek; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Ipswich, Yarmouth, Lynn, Boston, Hull, Newcastle or Berwick upon Tweed, or any of them, or any Member or Creek thereof, or other Place therein, shall perform their Quarantine in Whitebooth Road, between Hull and Grimsby; all Ships or Veffels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Carlifle and Chester, or either of them, or any Member or Creek thereof, or other Place therein, or to any Part of the Isle of Man, shall perform their Quarantine in a Place called Highlake, near Liverpool, at the Well End thereof; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Milford, Cardiff, Gloucester, Bristol, Bridgwater, or any of them, or any Member or Creek of them, or any of them, or to Padllow or St. Ive's, being Members of the Port of Plymouth, or to Ilfracombe or Barnstaple, being Members of the Port of Exeter, or to any other Place within the faid Ports of Milfo d, Cardiff, Gloucetter, Bristol or Bridgwater, or within the faid Members or Creeks, shall perform their Quarantine in Kingroad and Porshute Pill; all Ships and Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Pori of Plymouth, except fuch Parts thereof as have been herein before mentioned, or to the Port of Exeter, except fuch Parts thereof as have been herein before mentioned, or to the Port of Pool, or any of the Members or Creeks or other Places within the faid Ports of Plymouth, Exeter and Pool, except as herein before excepted, or to Falmouth, a Member of the Port of Plymouth, or any Creek thereof, or any other Place therein, shall perform their Quarantine in a Place called St. Ive's Pool, within the Mouth of the Harbour of Falmouth; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Ports of Southampton, Chichester, Sandwich, or any of them, or any of the Members or Creeks thereof, or of any of them, or any other Place within the same, shall perform their Quarantine at a Place called the Mother-Bank, near Portsmouth; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Eastern Coast of Scotland, comprehending the Ports of Leith, Borrowstoness. Alloa, Dunbar, Kirkaldy, Anstruther, Preston-Pans. Dundee, Perth, Montrose and Aberdeen, or to any Member, Creek or other Parts thereof, shall perform their Quarantine in Inverkeithing Bay; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Western Ports of Scotland, comprehending the Ports of Port Glasgow, Greenock, Irvine, Campbeltoun, Oban, Rothfay, Fort William, Air, Po t Patrick, Stranraer and Wigtoun, or to any Member, Creck or other Parts thereof, shall perform their Quarantine at Lamlash in the Island of Arran; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the Northern Ports of Scotland, comprehending the Ports of Inverness, Zetland, Orkney, Caithness and Stornaway, or to any Member, Creek or other Parts thereof, shall perform their Quarantine in Cromarty Bay in the Murray Firth; all Ships or Vessels which are or shall be bound to the South-West Ports of Scotland, comprehending
