An Act for declaring the Validity of Two Orders in Council, dated the Sixth Day of August, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-four, and the Thirtieth Day of March, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight; and for enlarging the Time of appealing in Prize Causes, and for permitting Appeals to be prosecuted after such Time shall have elapsed, in such special Causes as His Majesty, by any Order in Council shall authorize.

An Act to incorporate certain Persons, therein named, and their Successors, with proper Powers for Glass, originally established under an Act passed in the Thirteenth Year of His present Majesty's Reign,

which is now expired.
