Kingdom as may voluntarily offer themselves to be employed in Ireland.

An Act to continue until the End of the next Seffion of Parliament, and amend an Act paffed in the Thirty-fixth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty, Chapter One hundred and Six, videlicet,

y on the Eighteenth Day of May, One thousand feven hundred and ninety fix, for regulating the Allow-ance of the Drawbacks and Payment of the Bounty on the Exportation of Sugar.

An Act for repealing fo much of an Act made in the last Sellion of Parliament, intituled, An Act for granting to His Majefty certain Stamp Duties on the feveral Matters therein mentioned, and for better fecuring the Duties on Certificates to be taken out by Solicitors, Attornies, and others, practicing in certain Courts of Jullice in Great Britain, as impofes a Duty on Licences granted to flipendiary Curates to perform the Office of Curate in any Church or Chapel.

An Act to amend feveral Laws of Excife relating to Coachmakers, Auctioneers, Beer and Cyder exported, Certificates and Debentures, Stamps on Hides and Skins, Drawbacks on Wines and Sweets, and Ale and Beer Licences.

An Act to revive and continue, until the 1ft Day of January, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, an Act passed in the Fourteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, Chapter Forty-two, videlicet, on the Thirteench Day of January, One thousand feven hundred and feventy-four, intituled, An Act to prohibit the Importation of Light Silver

Coin of this Realm from Foreign Countries into 3.1 Great Britain or Ireland, and to restrain the Teoder thereof beyond a certain Sum; and to fuspend the Coining of Silver.

An Act for allowing Gold Wares to be manufactured at a Standard lower than is now allowed by Law.

An A& to prevent the Exportation of base Coin to His Majefty's Colonies in the Wett Indies and America.

An A& for defraying the Charge of the Pay and Cloathing of the Militia, in that Part of Great Britain called England, for One Year, from the Twenty-fifth Day of March, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight.

An Act for augmenting the Number of Field Officers and other Othcers of Militia, and for making other Provisions concerning the Militia Forces of this Kingdom

. An Act for making Allowances, in certain Cafes, to Subaltern Officers of the Militia in Time of Peace.

An Act for indemnifying Governors, Lieutenant-Governors, and Perfons acting as fuch, in the Weft India Islands, who have permitted the Importation and Exportation of Goods and Commodities in Foreign Bottoms.

An Act to continue, until the First Day of March, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, an Act made in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, intituled, An Act to continue and amend an Act, made in the Twenty-fixth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majesty, intituled, An Act for the more effectual Encouragement of the British Fisheries.

An Act for the further encouraging the Southern Whale Fisheries. . . . .

An Act for the further Encouragement of the Trade and Manufactures of the Isle of Man, for improving the Revenue thereof, and for the more effectual Prevention of Smuggling to and from the faid Ifland.

An A& for obviating and removing Doubts re-fpecting the holding of the Adjournments of the General Court of Quarter Seffion of the Peace in and for the County Palatine of Lancafter, and for authorizing the Juffices of the Peace acting in and for the faid County to hold an Annual General Seffion, and alfo a Special Seffion, for the Purpoles therein mentioned.

An A& for amending and rendering more effectual an Act made in the Thirty-fixth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefty, intituled, An Act to prevent Abufes and Frauds in the Packing, Weight and Sale of Butter. and to repeal certain Acts relating thereto.

An Act for amending an Act, made in the laft Seffion of Parliament, intituled, An ASt to amend and render more effectual an Act made in the Thirty-first Year of the Reign of His late Majefty King George the Second, intituled, An Act for the due making of Bread, and to regulate the Price and Alfize thereof, and to punifi Perions who shall adulterate Meal, Flour, or Bread, fo far as the fame relates to the Affize and Making of Bread, to be fold in the City of London, and the Liberties thereof, and within the Weekly Bills of Mortality, and within Ten Miles of the Royal Exchange.

An Act for preventing the depasturing of Forests, Commons, and Open Fields, with Sheep or Lambs infected with the Scab or Mange, in that Part of Great Britain called England.

An Act for raising a Body of Miners, in the Counties of Cornwall and Devon, for the Defence of the Kingdom during the prefent War.

An Act for incorporating the Commissioners ap-

pointed for erecting certain Light-houles in the Northern Parts of Great Britain. An Act for paving the Footways, and for cleanfing, lighting, and regulating the Streets and other public Passages and Places within the Borough of Malmefbury, in the County of Wilts, and the Avenues leading into the fame; and for removing and preventing Nuifances, Annoyances, and Obflructions therein.

An Act for making and maintaining a new Sewer upon Little Tower-hill, within the County of Middlefex.

An Act to explain, amend, and enlarge the Powers of an Act passed in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Reign of His prefent Majefly, intituled, an Act for widening and improving the Entrance into the City of London near Temple Bar; for making a more commodious Street or Paffage at Snow-hill; and for raifing, on the Credit of the Orphans Fund, a Sum of Money for those purposes. An Act to empower Magistrates and Juffices of the

Peace, in fetting the Affize of Bread, to make an Allowance on Account of the additional Duty on Salt.

An Act for authorifing the Truffees therein named, to raife Money by Rates or Affeffments within the Parifh of Saint Peter, in the Borough and Liberty of Saint Alban, in the County of Hertford, for the better and more effectually difcharging Annuities heretofore granted to certain Perfons who have advanced Money towards repairing the Church belonging to the faid Parish.
