from fuch other Perfort or Perfons whom We shall, from Time to Time, likewife authorize and appoint to grant fuch Licences.

And We do further authorize and require the faid Lord Mayor, and every other fuch Magiltrate or Officer as aforefaid, to whom any fuch Account shall be delivered as aforefaid, to grant, under his Hand and Seal, to the Alien delivering fuch Account, a Provisional Licence to fuch Alien to refide within this Kingdom, under fuch Reftrictions as shall appear fit, during the Time so allowed to such Alien for obtaining a Licence as aforesaid.

And We do further declare, That this Our Proclamation shall not extend to require any Alien to deliver fuch Account, and obtain fuch Licence as aforefaid, who is or shall be exempted from the Obligation to deliver fuch Account by Our Proclamation or Order in Council, or by Special War-rant from One of Our Principal Secretaries of State.

And We do further declare, That, according to the Provisions in the faid first-mentioned Act of Parliament, no Foreign Ambaffador, or other Publick Minister, duly authorized, nor the Domestic Servant of any fuch Foreign Ambaffador or Publick Minifter, registered as such according to the Directions of the Laws in Force for that Purpole, or being actually attendant on fuch Ambassador or Minister, is to be deemed an Alien within the Meaning of the faid Act.

And We alfo declare, That the Provisions in the faid Act do not affect any Alien, in respect of any Act done, or omitted to be done, who shall make it appear that he or she was not above the Age of Fourteen Years at the Time when such Act was so done or omitted to be done.

And We do further declare, That it is by the faid Act provided, that all fi;ch Licences, and Al-lowance of Time to obtain Licences as aforefaid, shall be given without Fee or Reward, and shall be fubject to no Duty or Charge whatfoever.

And We do further declare and make known, That every Alien who shall be found at large in Great Britain, after the Time by this Our Proclamation limited for his or her obtaining Our Royal Licence to refide in this Kingdom, will be liable to Imprifonment for any Time not exceeding One Year, or to Transportation beyond the Seas for any Time not exceeding Seven Years, unless fuch Alien fhall have obtained fuch Licence to refide in this Kingdom, or Allowance of Time unexpired to obtain the fame, or shall be exempted from the Obligation to deliver fuch Account as aforefaid by the faid Act, or by Our Proclamation or Order in Council, or by Special Warrant from One of Our Principal Secretaries of State.
