

Tanners, Curriers, Shoemakers, and other Artificers occupying the Cutting of Leather, and to repeal Parts of the said Act relating to the buying of Hides.

An Act for better supplying the Town and Port of Liverpool with Water from certain Springs in the Township of Bootle, in the County Palatine of Lancaſter.

An Act for better regulating and employing the Poor, and for more effectually watching the Squares, Streets, Lanes, and other Places, within that Part of the Pariſh of Saint Andrew, Holborn, which lies above the Bars, in the County of Middleſex, and the Pariſh of Saint George the Martyr, in the ſaid County.

An Act for the better and more effectual Relief and Employment of the Poor in the Hundred of Samford, in the County of Suffolk.

An Act to amend Two Acts, made in the Twenty-eighth and Thirty-eighth Years of the Reign of His preſent Maſteſty, for enlarging and improving the Harbour of Leith.

An Act for continuing for Thirty-eight Years, and rendering more effectual ſeveral Acts for charging a Duty of Two Pennies Scots, or One-Sixth Part of a Penny Sterling, on every Pint of Ale and Beer vendèd or ſold within the Towns of Port Glaſgow and Newark, and Privileges thereof.

An Act for continuing for Thirty-eight Years, and rendering more effectual, an Act, paſſed in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of His late Maſteſty, for continuing the Duty of Two Pennies Scots, or One-Sixth Part of a Penny Sterling, on every Pint of Ale and Beer vendèd or ſold within the City of Glaſgow and Village of Gorbals, and Liberties and Privileges thereof.

An Act for building a Bridge over the River Tweed, at or near the Town of Kelſo, in the County of Roxburgh.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seſſion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers of Two ſeveral Acts, the one paſſed in the Twenty-fifth Year of the Reign of His late Maſteſty King George the Second, and the other in the Fifth Year of the Reign of His preſent Maſteſty, for amending and keeping in Repair the Road leading from the North-Eaſt Corner of Nuſfield Common, by the Pariſh Church of Nuſfield, otherwiſe Tuſfield, in the County of Oxford, through Wallingford to Wantage, and from thence to Farringdon, in the County of Berks.

An Act for explaining and amending Two Acts, paſſed in the Thirty-firſt and Thirty-ſecond Years of the Reign of His preſent Maſteſty, for repairing the Roads from Livingſtone, by the Kirk of Shotts, to the City of Glaſgow, and other Roads therein mentioned.

An Act for making and repairing the Road from Dunkeld to Coupar of Angus, by the Bridge of Iſla, and the Road leading out of the Road between Dunkeld and Perth to the Boat at Caputh, by or through the Village of Stanley, in the County of Perth, to continue in force for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seſſion of Parliament.

An Act for more effectually repairing and amending the Road leading from Long Horſeley Bar or

Gate, on the Poſt Road near the Town of Morpeth, by or through Long Horſeley, Weldon Bridge, and Whittingham, to the River Breaniff, and from thence to Piercy's Croſs, in the County of Northumberland, to continue in force for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seſſion of Parliament.

An Act for altering, enlarging, and repealing ſome of the Proviſions in an Act, paſſed in the Eighteenth Year of the Reign of His preſent Maſteſty, for repairing ſeveral Roads leading from the Town of Taunton, and other Roads adjoining thereto, in the County of Somerſet, and alſo for extending the Proviſions of the ſaid Act to a Road from Tucker's Gate, in the Pariſh of Lyng, to Piper's Inn, in the Pariſh of Aſhcott, in the ſaid County of Somerſet.

An Act for more effectually amending, widening, and keeping in Repair the Road from the Turnpike Road at the Bottom of Shaw Hill, in the Pariſh of Melkſham, through Gøoge's Lane, Corſham, Biddeſton, and Weſt Yatton, to the Turnpike Road at Upper Coombe, in the Pariſh of Caſtle Coombe, in the County of Wilts.

An Act for more effectually repairing, widening, altering, and improving the Road at or near Beckhampton, and from the North Side of Swindon, to the Carpenter's Arms in Blunſden, and ſeveral other Roads therein mentioned, in the County of Wilts.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seſſion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and amending the Powers of Three ſeveral Acts, paſſed in the Twenty-fifth, Twenty-ſeventh, and Thirty-third Years of the Reign of His late Maſteſty King George the Second, for repairing and widening the Road leading from Market Harborough, in the County of Leiſceſter, to the Pound, in the Pariſh of Brampton, in the County of Huntingdon.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seſſion of Parliament, the Term, and enlarging and altering the Powers of Two Acts, the one paſſed in the Thirtieth Year of the Reign of His late Maſteſty King George the Second, and the other in the Second Year of the Reign of His preſent Maſteſty, for amending, widening, and keeping in Repair the Road leading from Burleigh Bridge, in the Town of Loughborough, to Aſhby-de-la-Zouch, in the County of Leiſceſter, and for repairing and widening the Road branching out of the ſaid Road at Coleorton Church, over Coleorton Moor, and through Worthington and Sutton Bonington to Rempſton, in the Counties of Leiſceſter and Nottingham.

An Act for more effectually amending, widening, improving, and keeping in Repair the Road from Gateshead, in the County of Durham, to the Church-Lane, near Ryton-Lane Head, and from the Bar-Moor to the Hexham Turnpike Road, near Daſton-Bar, in the County of Northumberland, and alſo ſeveral other Roads therein deſcribed, lying within the ſaid Counties.

An Act for more effectually repairing and improving the Road from Skipton, in the County of York, to Clitheroe, in the County of Lancaſter.

An Act for veſting Part of the ſettled Eſtates of the Right Honorable John Lord Roſſe in Truſtees to ſell or exchange the ſame, and purchaſe or
