### PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. W HEREAS His Majefty was gracioufly plcafed, by His Royal Proclamation bearing Date the Twenty-fixth Day of December, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-two, to promise and declare, that the Bounties of Five Pounds for every Able Seaman, and Two Pounds Ten Shillings every Able Seaman, and Two Pounds Ten Shillings for every Ordinary Seaman, fit for His Majefty's Service, fhould be paid in the Manner thereby di-rected to every fuch Able and Ordinary Seaman, not above the Age of Fifty nor under the Age of Twenty Years, who fhould, on or before the Twenty-eighth Day of February then following, enter themfelves to ferve in His Majefty's Royal Navy, either with the Captains or Lieutenants of His Majefty's Ships or Veffels, or Officers em-ployed on Shore for raifing Men for the Service of the Royal Navy : And whereas His Majefty was alfo gracioufly pleafed, by his faid Proclama-tion, to declare, that all Able-bodied Landmen, not above the Age of Thirty-five nor under the Age above the Age of Thirty-five nor under the Age of Twenty Years, who should so enter themselves as aforefaid, should receive the Sum of Thirty Shillings each Man, as His Majefty's Royal Bounty : And whereas His Majefty was alfo gracioully pleafed, by His Royal Proclamation bearing Date the Sixteenth Day of the faid Month of February, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-three, to promife and declare, that a Reward of Twenty Shillings for every Able and Ordinary Seaman, fit to ferve on board His Majefty's Ships, fhould be paid to any Perfon who fhould difcover any Seaman or Seamen who might conceal him or themfelves, fo that fuch Seaman or Seamen should be taken for His Majesty's Service, on or before the Thirtieth Day of April then next, by any of His Majefty's Sea Officers appointed to raife Men on Shore, or by the Captains or Commanders of any of His Majefty's Ships or Veffels in the Ports or on the Coafts of this Kingdom: And whereas the Time limited by the faid Proclamations for Payment of the faid Bounties and Reward hath been prolonged and extended to the Thirty-first Day of this instant

August; and it being judged expedient for His Majefty's Service that the faid Bounties and Re-ward should be continued to be paid for some and govern themfelves accordingly.

SIR, -I Have to acquaint you of my Arrival at this An-chorage with His Majefty's Sloop under my Command, and of my having, in Company with

the Pylades Sloop and Courier Cutter, cut out and defirous of accepting the faid Appointment, (under the took Possellion of, on the 11th Instant, from Shiermannikcog, the Crafh Gun Brig, (formerly in our Service,) mounting Twelve Guns, Eighteen, Service,) mounting Twelve Guns, Eighteen, Twenty-four, and Thirty-two-Pounders; as alfo having burnt a Schooner of Seventy Men; likewife took Poffeffion of a Row Boat, of Thirty Men : we the landed on the Island, (having previously drove the Men from the Battery,) spiked Four Pieces of Cannon, and brought off Two Brass Field Pieces, Four-Pounders.

The Crash made an obstinate Resistance from Forty to Fifty Minutes, and then ftruck.

I am happy to add not more than Two Men were killed on our Side, and Three Wounded, and recommend the Crash as an excellent Vessel well calculated for His Majefty's Service, being of a fmall Draught of Water. I cannot but exprefs my Satisfaction on our keeping the Ships afloat, as in many Places our Soundings proved there to be not more than Fourteen Feet, the Elpiegle drawing Twelve.


