## LORD DUNCAN'S VICTORY.

T a Committee appointed for conducting the Subfeription raifed for the Relief of the Sufferers in the Action on the memorable 11th Day of October 1797, it appearing that out of One Thoufand and Twenty-three Perfons, who were Willed or wounded in the gallant Aftion under Admiral Lord Duncan that the Committee have not, with all their Inquiries, been able to find out the following Lift of Seventy Perfons, or their Families:

Refolved.

That an Advertifement be inferted in the London Gazette, the Daily and Country Papers, containing the Lift of Per-fons who were killed or wounded on that Day, who have not by themfelves, their Families, or Relatives, yet received Gratuities from this Committee; and that all Perfons 6 en-titled to Relief be defired to fend to Mr. White, their Secre-tary, in Writing, the State and Number of their Families, and their Places of Relidence, and if wounded, the Nature and State of their Wounds; the fame to be attefted by the Minifter and Churchwardens, or by the Chief Magiftrate of the Places or Parifhes to which the Parties fo applying re-fpectively belong, in order that this Committee might be enabled to transmit to them, free of all Expence, fuch Gratuities as they may deem expedient, without the Neceflity of an Agent, or of the Parties coming up to Town. K I L That an Advertisement be inserted in the London Gazette,

Lloyd's Coffee-Houle, December 6, 1799, As fome of the Officers and Seamen who were wounded on the 11th Day of October 1797, have been transferred over, or have been exchanged into other Ships, and have not, from these Causes, yet received their final Gratuities,

Refolved

Reloived, That all all fuch Officers and Scamen do transmit to this Committee their Names, and the Names of the Ships in which they fo gallantly ferved on that Day, together with the State of their Cafes, the Number and Relidence of their Families, attefted by the Commanding Officer of the Ships to which they now refjectively belong, that this Committee may remit to them or to their Families fuch Gratuities as the Committee have been enabled, by the Liberality of the Committee have been enabled, by the Liberality of the Public, to grant.

Refolved, That all Applications be made to this Committee, in Writing, on or before the 30th Day of June 1800: that only those refident in London need apply in Person to Mr. White on every Saturday, between the Hours of Eleven and One o'Clock: and all Persons refident in the Country, or who are on actual Service, be requeited to make their Application, by Poft, in the Manner above defcribed : and that no Application through Agents be attended to.
