An Act for continuing the Term and chlarging the Powers of an Act passed in the Twenty-first Year of the Reign of His present Majesty for repairing and widening the Road leading from the Port of Borrowstownness, by the Westrof the Borrough of Linlithgow, and by the Towns of Torphichen, Bathgate, and Whiteburn, and from thence Southward to the Confines of the County of Linlithward to the road Hilbertsky. lithgow, at or near Hollhouseburn."

An Act to continue for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Sellion of Parliament, the Term, and after and enlarge the Powers of Two Acts passed in the Thirty third Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, and in the Eighteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for repairing and widening the Road from the Bars of Boughton within the Liberties of the City of Chester, to Whitchurch, and from thence to Newport in the County of Salop, and feveral other Roads therein mentioned, fo far as the faid Acts relate to the Road leading from Newport aforefaid to the Village or Place called Welsh Harp, in the Township of Stounall in the County of Stafford, being the Third Diffrict of the faid Roads.

An Act for more effectually repairing, widening, altering, and improving, the Roads therein mentioned leading from the Town of Leominster in the County of Hereford.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Sef-fion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and en-larging the Powers of Two Acts paffed in the Thirtieth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second; and in the Nineteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for amending, widening, and keeping in repair, feveral Roads therein mentioned, so far as the said Acts relate to the Road leading from the Town of Ruthim in the County of Denbigh, to the Town of Mold, in the County of Flint.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years,

and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers of several Acts passed for amending the Highway between Heckliste and Woburn in the County of Bedford, and for repairing the Road leading through Woburn to Tickford Bridge in

Newport Pagnell in the County of Bucks.

An Act for continuing for Twenty one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and enlarging the Powers of Two Acts passed in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, and in the Eighteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for amending, repairing, and widening, the Roads leading from the Ryeway in the Parish of Yarpole in the County of Hereford to Presteigne in the County of Radnor, and several other Roads therein mentioned in the faid County of Radner, and in the Counties of Hereford and Salop.

An Act for enlarging the Term and Powers of an Act made in the Seventeenth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, for amending and keeping in re-pair the Road from the Town of Warminster in the County of Wilts, to a Place where the Roads to Bath and Briffol divide; and from the Town of Frome to the Town of Beckington in the County of Somerset, and other Roads therein mentioned.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Selfion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and en-larging the Powers of Two Acts passed in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of His late Ma-jelly King, George the Second, and the Sixteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for re-pairing and widening the Road leading from the East Side of Lincoln Heath to the City of Peterborough, and feveral other Roads therein mentioned in the Counties of Northampton and Lincoln.

An Act for continuing for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and altering and chlarging the Powers of Two Acts passed in the Twenty-fixth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, and in the Fourteenth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for repairing and widening several Roads leading from the Town of Bewdley, in the County of Worcester, to the several Places therein mentioned in the Counties of Worcester and Salop respectively.

An Act to continue for Twenty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the then next Seffion of Parliament, the Term, and alter and enlarge the Powers of Two Acts passed in the Thirtieth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty. King George the Second, and in the Fifth Year of the Reign of His present Majcsty, for repairing and widening the Roads leading from Spalding High Bridge through Littleworth, and by Frognall and over James Deeping Stone Bridge, in the County of Lincoln, to Maxey Outgang, in the County of Northampton, adjoining to the High Road there.
