Arrival of any fuch Ship or Veffel from the Places before-mentioned at any of the Out-ports of this Kingdom, or at any of the Iflands aforefaid, the proper Officer of the Cuftoms, at the Place appointed for the Performance of Quarantine at fuch Places, fhall go alongfide fuch Ship or Veffel in a Boat, (keeping to Windward,) and fhall fee the Crew and all other Performs belonging to or being on board fuch Ship or Veffel, muftered on the Gang-way; and the Superintendant of Quarantine, or his Affilfant, or the proper Officer of the Cuftoms appointed for the Performance of Quarantine, thall then and there, in the Prefence of the Crew, put the following Queflions to the Mafter or other Perfor having Charge of the Ship or Veffel, who fhall anfwer the fame upon Oath, viz.

What is the Name of the Veffel, and from whence does the come?

What is the Name of the Commander ?

Is the Bill of Health clean or unclean, or fufpected ? Produce it.

Is the Inftrument now produced the true and only Bill of Health, or is there any other on board the Veffel? if there is, produce the fame.

Has there been any Sicknefs on board in the Courle of the Voyage? if fo, of what Nature? Has any Perfon died on board in the Courle of

the Voyage? if fo, of what Difeafe, and when ?

Are all Perfons now on board in good Health? At what Place or Places was the Cargo taken on

board ? Of what does the Cargo confift ?

VI. And it is hereby further ordered, That the Anfwers to the aforefaid Questions shall be taken down in Writing, and the Superintendant of Qua-rantine, or his Affiltant, with the Advice of the Medical Attendant at Standgate Creek, and in cafe of a Ship or Veffel bound to any of the Out-ports or Islands aforefaid, the proper Officer of the Cuftoms at the Places appointed for the Performance of Quarantine at such Out-ports or Places, shall appoint a proper Place for the Mafter, or other Person having Charge of the Ship or Veffel, to repair to, who thereupon shall, as foon as possible, after having answered the foregoing Questions, repair to such Place, carrying with him the Log-Book, Manifest, and all the Ship's Papers, all of which shall be delivered to the Superintendant of Quarantine, or his Affiftant, at Standgate Creek, or to the proper Officer of the Cuftoms at the Out-ports or Islands aforefaid, (as the Cafe may be,) the faid Log-Book, Manifeft, and Papers, having been firft immerfed in Vinegar and fumigated; and fuch Master, or other Perfon, shall then folemnly make Oath to the Truth of the Contents of fuch Log-Book, and that every particular Entry therein was made as foon after the Fact as possible; and also to the Truth of all the other Papers fo delivered, as well as to the Truth of his Anfwers to the following Queflions, which Queflions are to be then and there put to him by the Superintendant of Quarantine, or his Affiftant, or by luch proper Officer of the Cuftoms, as the Cafe thall be, viz.

On what Day did you arrive at the Place or Places where you 'took in the Whole, or any, and what Part of the Cargo, and on what Day did you fail from fuch Place or Places; and what Part of your Cargo was taken in at each Place, and when ?

What Place or Places did you touch at during the Voyage?

Did the Plague or any other contagious Diftemper prevail in any Degree at any of the Places at which your Cargo was taken on board, or at which you touched ? if at any, fay at which, and when ? Did you meet with any British Ships or Veffels at

Did you meet with any British Ships or Veffels at any of the Places you have been at ? if you did, fay when, where, and what were the Names and Destinations of such Ships or Vessels.

Did you leave any British Ships or Vessels at any of the Ports you have failed from? if you did, mention their Names, and the Names of the Commanders.

Were fuch Ships loading ; were they near their Departure, and whither were they bound ?

Do you know whether any Foreign Veffels loading at the Port from which you failed were bound beyond the Streights of Gibraltar? and if fo, what were they, and whither were they bound?

How long have you been upon the Voyage?

Have you fpoken to or otherwife had any Communication with any Veffel at Sea during the Voyage? if you have, fay when, where, and the Nature of the Communication held. Were there any Letters, Parcels, or other Articles delivered or received into your Ship or Veffel from any Ship or Veffel met with on the Voyage, or until your Arrival at the Place where you were put under Quarantine by the proper Officer of the Cultoms, and the Delivery of your Papers to fuch Officer; and what were fuch Letters, Parcels, or Articles ?

What were the Ships or Veffels you fpoke to or had Communication with, and what were their Deftinations refpectively? and what do you know refpecting the State of Health on board fuch Ships or Veffels?

In the Courfe of your Voyage, has any of your Ship's Crew or Paffengers fuffered from Illnefs of any Kind? what was the Nature of fuch Illnefs? when did it prevail? how many Perfons were affected by it? are there any Convalefcents on board? are all on board at prefent in good Health?

What Number of Perfons, if any, have died on board during the Voyage? when and in what Part of the Voyage did fuch Perfons die?

Were there any of those who died fuspected at the Time to have died of a contagious Diftemper? were their Bedding and Clothes destroyed? if fo, when, and in what Manner? were any of the Perfons immediately employed about the Sick afterwards taken ill? if fo, of what Discafe?

At what precife Time after leaving Port did luch Deaths happen? in how many Days after being firft indifpofed did the Sick die? what were the moft obvious Appearances of the Difeafe?

Did you touch at the Isle of Rhodes, the Morea, or any and what Part of the Coast of Africa, within or without the Mediterranean? and if so, at what Time or Times respectively? and had you any and what Communication with the Shore at those respective Places? did any Person on board communicate during the Voyage in any Manner whatever with any Ship or Vessel coming from any of those Places? if so, when and in what Manner? and what do you know of the State of Health of the Persons on board fuch Ships or Vessels?

Do you know whether any Perfon whatever employed in loading your Vellel, or in bringing any
