THE Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury having appointed Money for the Payment of Half-Pay to Sea Officers, from the 1st January to the 30th June 1801, according to His Majesty's Establishment on that Behalf;

These are to give Notice, that the several Payments will begin to be made at the Pay-Office, by the Treasurer of His Majesty's Navy, at Ten o'Clock in the Morning, on the following Days:

On Monday the 21st Instant, to Admirals, Captains, and their Attornies.

On Tuesday the 22d Instant, and Wednesday 23d Instant, to Lieutenants, and their Attornies.

On Thursday 24th Instant, to Masters and Surgeons, and their Attornies.

After which the List will be recalled the first and third Wednesdays in every Month, that all Persons may then and there attend to receive what may become payable to them, and not only bring with them the Affidavit required, touching their not having enjoyed the Benefit of any public Employment either at Sea or on Shore during the Time they are to be paid their Half-Pay, but also to produce Certificates that they have subscribed to the Test, and taken the Oaths of Allegiance required by Act of Parliament to His present Majesty; and in case any of the said Officers should not be able to attend themselves, but employ Attornies for that Purpose, that the said Attornies do produce the like Certificates and Affidavits from the Persons they are employed by.

Where Officers are Abroad on Leave, their Agents are to produce attested Copies of such Leave before the Half-Pay can be paid.

And, as by Act of Parliament passed in the Thirty-fifth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for establishing a more easy and expeditious Method for the Payment of Officers belonging to His Majesty's Navy," it is enacted by the 20th Clause of the said Act, "That if any Commissioned or Warrant Naval Officer who shall be entitled to receive Half-Pay, and shall be desirous to receive and be paid the same at or near to the Place of his Residence, he may apply to the Treasurer of His Majesty's Navy in London, to have such Half-Pay paid at or near the Place of his Residence in the Manner pointed out by the said Act."

Notice is hereby further given, that the Half-Pay ending the 30th June 1801, will commence paying on the 21st Instant; and all Persons desirous of having their Half-Pay remitted to them may apply as above directed.

NEW STAMP DUTIES ON DEEDS, &c..

Stamp-Office, Somerset-Place, July 3, 1801.

IN pursuance of Directions received from the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, His Majesty's Commissioners for managing the Stamp Duties do hereby give Notice, That, in order to prevent any Inconvenience to those Persons in the different Parts of the Kingdom, who shall not have been able to supply themselves with Vellum, Parchment, and Paper stamped according to an Act of Parliament, to which the Royal Assent was given

Yesterday, owing to the Period for its Commencement taking place so soon after the passing thereof, there is a Clause in the said Act, empowering the Commissioners to cause such Instruments, viz. any Indenture, Lease, or other Deed, charged with an additional Duty of Three Shillings by an Act of the Thirty-seventh of the King, Cap. 90. as may, through Necessity, have been executed by any, or all of the Parties, upon Stamps in Use previous to the Year 1801, to be stamped with the additional Duties of FIVE SHILLINGS granted by Two Acts of the last Session of Parliament, on Payment of the said Duties only, without any Penalty, provided the same shall be brought or sent to the Head Office in Somerset-Place, before the ensuing 5th of December.
