The KING's Most Excellent Majefty in Council.

WHEREAS the Time limited by His Majefty's VV Order in Council of the Fourth Day of June last, prohibiting the Exportation out of this Kingdom, or carrying Coaftwife, Gunpowder or Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, will expire upon the Seventh Day of this initant December: And whereas it is judged expedient for His Majefty's Service that the faid Prohibition thould be continued for fome Time longer; His Majefty doth therefore, with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Perfon or Perfons whatfoever (except the Mafter General of the Ordnance for His Majefty's Service) do, at any Time during the Space of Two Months, to commence from the Seventh Day of this inflant December, prefume to transport into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coastwife, any Gunpowder or Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, or ship or lade any Gunpowder or Saltpetre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, on board any Ship or Veffel, in order to transporting the fame into any Parts be-yond the Seas, or carrying the fame Coaflwife, without Leave or Permillion in that Behalf first obtained from His Majefty, or His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring and fuffering the refpective Forfeitures and Penalties inflicted by an Act, paffed in the Twenty-ninth Year of His late Majefty's Reign, intituded " An Act to empower His Ma-" jelly to prolibit the Exportation of Saltpetre, " and to enforce the Law for empowering 14is Ma-" jefty to prohibit the Exportation of Gunpowder, " or any Sort of Arms and Aminumition ; and alfo " to empower His Majefty to reltrain the carrying "Coaltwife of Saltpetre, Gunpowder, or any Sort

HEREAS the Time limited by His Majefty's Order in Council of the Fourth Day of June last, prohibiting the Transportation into any Parts out of this Kingdom, of the Wood called Lignum Vitæ, will expire upon the Tenth Day of this inftant December : And whereas it is judged expedient for His Majefty's Service that the faid Prohibition should be continued for fome Time longer; His Majefty doth therefore, with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Perfon or Perfons whofoever do, at any Time during the Space of Two Months, to commence from the Tenth Day of this inftant December, export, or attempt to export, transport, carry, or convey, or lade, or lay on board of any Ship, Vessel, or Boat, in order to be exported, trans-ported, carried; or conveyed out of this Kingdom, any of the Wood called Lignum Vitz, without Leave or Permillion being first had and obtained of His Majefty or His Privy Council : But it is, nevertheles, His Majefty's Pleasure, that nothing herein contained shall extend, or be construed to extend, to prevent any Ship or Vellel from taking or having on board any of the faid Wood called Lignum Vitæ, which may be neceffary for the Ufc of the faid Ship or Vellel during the Courfe of her intended Voyage; nor to prevent the Eri portation of the faid Wood called Lignum Vite to Ireland, or to His Majefty's Mands of Guerns fey, Jerfey, Alderney, Sark, or Man, or to His Majefty's Colonies or Plantations in America or "to empower His Majelty to rearrain the carrying Majelty's Colones of Plantations in America or "Coaltwife of Saltpere, Gunpowder, or any Sort "of Arms or Ammunition."—And the Right Ho-norable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majelty's Africa, or to the Island of St. Helena, or to the Salt St. Helena, or to the St. Helena, or tot the St. Helena, the St. Helena, or to the S
