- The Captains of Marines and Land-Forces, Sea Lieutenants, and Mafter on board, fhall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongft them: but that every Phylician appointed, or hereafter to be appointed to a Fleet or Squadron of Our Ships of War, fhall, in the Diftribution of Prizes which fhall hereafter be taken by the Ships in which he fhall ferve, or in which fuch Ships' Company fhall be entitled to fhare, be claffed with the Sea Lieutenants with refpect to the faid One Eighth Part, and be allowed to fhare equally with them: provided fuch Phyfician be actually on board at the Time of taking fuch Prizes:
- The Lieutenants and Quarter Masters of Marines, and Lieutenants, Enfigns, and Quarter Masters of Land Forces, Secretaries of Admirals or of Commodores, with Captains under them, Second-Lieute of Line of Battle Ships, Boatfwains, Gunners, Purfers, Carpenters, Masters' Mates, Chirurgeons, Pilots, and Chaplaine on board, shall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongst them:
- The Midshipmen, Captains' Clerks, Master Sailmakers, Carpenters' Mates, Boatswains' Mates, Gunners' Mates, Masters at Arms, Corporals, Yeomen of the Sheets, Coxswains, Quarter-Masters, Quarter-Masters' Mates, Chirurgeons' Mates, Yeomen of the Powder-Room, Serjeants of Marines and Land Forces on board, shall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongst them:
- The Trumpeters, Quarter-Gunners, Carpenters' Crew, Stewards, Cook, Armourers, Stewards' Mates, Cooks' Mates, Gunfmiths, Coopers, Swabbers, Ordinary Trumpeters, Barbers, Able Seamen, Ordinary Scamen, and Marines and other Soldiers, and all other Perfons doing Duty and affilting on board, shall have Two Eighth Parts to be equally divided amongit them.

And We do hereby further order, That in the cafe of Cutters, Schooners, and other armed Veffels commanded by Lieutenants, the Share of fuch Lieutenants fhall be Three Eighth Parts of the Prize, unlefs fuch Lieutenants fhall be under the Command of a Fiag Officer or Officers, in which Cafe the Flag Officer or Officers in all have One of the faid Three cighths, to be divided among fuch-Flag Officer or Officers, in the fame Manner hereinbefore directed, in the Cafe of Captains ferving under Flag Officers.

Secondly, We direct, That the Share of the Mafter or other Perfon acting as Second in Command, and the Pilot, (if there happens to be one on board,) fhall be One Eighth Part, to be divided into Three Equal Parts, of which Two Thirds fhall go to the Mafter, or other Perfon acting as Second in Command, and the remaining One Third to the Pilot; but, if there is no Pilot, then fuch Eighth Part to go wholly to the Mafter or Perfon acting as Second in Command :

That the Share of the Chirurgeon, or Surgeon's Mate (where there is no Chirurgeon), Midfhipmen, Clerk, and Steward, shall be One Eighth:

That the Share of the Boatswain's, Gunner's, and Carpenter's Mates, Yeoman of the Sheets, Sail-Maker, Quarter-Master, and Quarter-Master's Mate, shall be One Eighth :

And the Share of the Scamen, Marines, and other

Perfons on board, affilting in the Capture, shall be Two Eighth Parts.

But it is Our Intention, neverthelefs, that the above Diftribution fhall only extend to fuch Captures as fhall be made by any Cutter, Schooner, or Armed Veffel, without any of Our Ships or Veffels of War being prefent, or within Sight of, and adding to the Encouragement of the Captors, and Terror of the Enemy; but in cafe any of Our Ships or Veffels of War fhall be prefent or in Sight, that then the Officers, Pilots, Petty Officers, and Men on board fuch Cutters and Schooners, or armed Veffels, fhall fhare in the fame Proportion as is allowed to Perfons of the like Rank and Denomination on board of Our Ships and Veffels of War; and fuch Cutters, Schooners, or Armed Veffels, fhall not, in refpect to fuch Captures, convey any Intereft or Share in the Flag Eighth to the Flag Officer or Officers, under whofe Orders fuch Cutters, Schooners, and Armed Veffels, may happen to be.

And whereas it is judged expedient, during the prefent Hoftilities, to hire into Our Service Armcd Veffels, to be employed as Cruizers againft the Enemy, which Veffels are the Property of, and their Mafters and Crews are paid by, the Merchants of whom they are hired, although feveral of them are commanded by Our Commiffioned Officers in Our Pay; it is Our further Will and Pleafure, that the neat Produce of all Prizes taken by fuch Hired Armed Veffels (except as hereinafter mentioned) thall be for the Benefit of Our Commiffioned Officers in Our Pay, and of the Mafters and Crews on board the faid Hired Armed Veffels at the Time of the Capture, and that fuch Prizes may be lawfully fold and difpoled of by them and their Agents, after the fame thall have been to Us finally adjudged lawful Prize, and not otherwife; the Diftribution thereof thall be as follows:

The Whole of the next Produce being divided into Eight equal Parts;

Our Officer commanding any Hired Armed Veffel, who shall be actually on board at the taking of any Prize, shall have Three Eighths; but in cafe such Hired Armed Vessel shall be under the Command of a Flag or Flags, the Flag Officer or Officers being actually on board, or directing and affilting in the Capture, shall have Que of the faid Three Eighth Parts, the faid One Eighth Part to be paid to such Flag or Flag Officers in such Proportions, and subject to such Regulations as are herein aftermentioned:

In cafe there be acting on board fuch Hired Armed Veffel, besides Our Officer commanding the fame, one or more of Our commissioned Sea Lieutenants in Our Pay, fuch Lieutenant or Lieutenants shall take One Eighth

One Eighth shall belong to the Master and Mate, of which the Master shall take Two Thirds, and the Mate One Third; but in case there shall be acting on board such Hired Armed Vessel one or more Midshipmen, or other Person in Our Pay, of those who are classed with Midshipmen in the former Part of this Our Proclamation, in that case, the Master shall take One Half of the Eighth, and the other Half shall be equally divided between the Mate, Midshipmen, and such other Persons in Our Pay:

Three Eighths shall belong to, and be divided
