The King has been gracioufly pleafed to grant unto William Soper, of Alhburton, in the County of Devon, and of Pulroffie, in the Shire of Sutherland, Elq; late Commissioner of the Honorable Company's Cuftoms at the Port of Surat, in the East Indies, and to Harriet his Wife, his Royal Licence and Authority, that they, and the Iffue of their Marriage, may affume, ufe, and bear the Sur-name of Dempster, in Addition to their prefent name of Dempiter, in Addition to their optient Surname of Soper, purfuant to a Claufe in a Deed of Entail of John Hamilton Dempfter, of Pul-roffie aforefaid, late Captain of the Ship Earl Tal-bot, in the Service of the Honorable Eafl India Company, deceafed, bearing Date 15th October 1799; and alfo that the faid William Soper, and Harrist his Wife, may bear the Arms of Dempfor Harriet his Wife, may bear the Arms of Dempster quarterly with those of Soper; fuch Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms, and recorded in the Heralds' Office:

And alfo to order, that this His Majefty's Conceffion and Declaration be registered in His College of Arms, otherwife to be void and of none Effect.
