WHEREAS by an Act paffed in the Fortyfecond Year of His prefent Majefty's Reign, intitled an Act to alter and amend an Act passed in the Thirty-ninth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intitled, " An Act for rendering more com-" modious and for better regulating the Port of " London, fo far as the fame relates to the Concerns " of the Weft India Dock Company thereby efta-

And be it further enacted, That when any One or more of the fuid Docks by the faid recited Act and this Act authorized to be made and built by the faid Directors, with the Bafon or Bafons, Quays, Wharfs, Warehoufes, and other Works belonging or to belong thereto, shall be so far completed that in the Judgment of the Lord High Treasurer, or any Three or more of the Lords Commissioners of His Mainter's Treasure for the Dires being the form any i nee or more of the Lords Commissioners of this a Majelty's Treafury for the Time being, the fame fhall be fit for the Reception of Ships and Goods respectively, it fhall be lawful for the faid Lord High Treafurer, or any Three or more of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the Time being, and he and they are hereby refpectively authorized and empowered, by Writing under his or their Hand or Hands, to certify and make known the fame, which Certificate shall be published Three
