of the Twelfth of this inftant August, requiring the Aliens therein mentioned to refide within the Limits therein deferibed, except in Cafes where any Aliens as aforefaid, thall be *lond fide* proceeding on their Journey to the Port of London and to Gravefend, in order to embark and depart thereat from Great Britain.

Provided always, that this Our Proclamation shall not extend to any Foreign Ambassiador, or other public Minister duly anthorised, or the Servants actually attending upon fuch Ambaffador or public Minifler, or any domeftic Servant of any of Our natural born Subjects, or of any Subject who has been made Denizen or naturalized, fuch Servant being actually and *boná fide* employed in the Service of their refpective Mallers; nor to any fuch Alien as shall, by virtue of a Licence under the Hand and Seal of One of Our Principal Secretaries of State, or of fuch Perfon or Perfons as shall be appointed for that Purpole, be authorifed to dwell and relide in fome Part of Great Britain.

We do hereby charge and command that all Aliens to whom this relates, do pay due Chedience to the fame, and that all Juffices of the Peace, Mayors, and other Magistrates, and all Coustables and other Peace Officers, do respectively use their utmost Diligence to enforce the fame.

Given at Our Court at St. James's, this Thirtyfirst Day of August One thousand eight hundred and three, and in the Forty-third Year of Our Reign.
