The Lugger went on Shore about Half a Mile to the Westward of Gravelines; Lieutenant Starck anchored the Millbrook within Masket-Shot of her, and in the Evening a heavy Fire was opened upon her from the Shove with some Field Pieces, which, however, did no Sort of Damage, and I am happy to fay, that on our Side not a Man was hurt.
