An Act for combling the Lord Lieutenant, or other Chief Governor or Governors of Ireland, to prohibit, until the Twenty fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and five, the Distillation of Spirits from Oats or Oatmeal in Ireland; and for indomnifying such Persons as have acted in advising or carrying into Execution a Proclamation of the Lord Lieutenant and Council of Ireland for prohibiting fuch Distillation.

An Act to continue several Laws relating to the suspending the Operation of Two Acts of the Fifteenth and Seventeenth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty for restraining the Negociation of Promissory Notes and Bills of Exchange under a limited Sum in England; and to the prohibiting the Exportation from, and permitting the Importation to Great Britain of Corn; and for allowing the Importation of other Articles of Provision without Payment of Duty until the Twenty-fifth Day of March One thousand eight hundred and five; and to the regulating the Trade and Commerce to and from the Isle of Malta, until Six Months after the Ratification of a Definitive Treaty of Peace.

An Act to continue until the Twenty-fifth Day

of March One thousand eight hundred and five, so much of an Act made in the Forty first Year of His prefent Majelty's Reign as relates to the prohibiting the Exportation from Ireland, of Corn or Potatoes, or other Provisions, and to the permitting the Importation into Ireland, of Corn, Fish, and Provisions

without Payment of Duty.

An Act to amend Two Acts passed in the Forty-tirst and Forty-third Years of the Reign of His present Majesty for permitting Portugal Wine to be landed and warehoused in the United Kingdom, and to allow Spanish Wine to be so landed and warehoused.
