SIR.

NCLOSED is an Extract of a Letter from Captain Columbine, of His Majefty's Ship Ulyffes, giving an Account of his capturing a fmall Privateer.

Extract of a Letter from Captain Columbine, of His Majefly's Ship Ulyffes, to Commodore Hood, dated May 7, 1804.

N the 30th of April we fell in with, off the Bocas, and captured, after a few Hours Chafe, Le Petit Decidé, a French Lugger Privateer, J. Bideau, Master, with One long Brass Four-Pounder and Twenty-fix Men; quite new, had been a Fortnight from Guadaloupe, but had taken nothing.
