And it is hereby notified, that all the Private Men on the Out-Penfion of Chelfea-Hofpital, refiding in South Britain, exclusive of Wales, difcharged as alorefaid, (except as above excepted,) who shall not appear at the Times and Places herein appointed, will be considered by Government as otherwife provided for, or as dead, and they will ac-cordingly be ftruck off the Books of the Out-Penfion of the faid Hospital, without any Prospect of being reflored thereto.
