LONDON DOCKS.

WHEREAS by an Act, passed in the Fortieth
Year of the Reign of His present Majesty,
intituled "An Act for making Wet Docks, Basons,
" Cuts, and other Works, for the greater Accom-
" modation and Security of Shipping, Commerce,
" and Revenue within the Port of London;" it is
enacted, That from and after Notice of the Com-
pletion of the Dock or Docks thereby authorized to
be made, should be given by public Advertisement
in the London Gazette, and in Two or more public
