## The SOVEREIGN.

The Sovereign and Knights Companions being feated, the Register, in the Absence of the Chancellor, fignified to the Chapter the Sovereign's Pleafure for filling up the vacant Stall in St. George's Chapel at Windfor; and as, by the Statutes, none but a Knight can be elected, Garter was commanded to introduce the Earl of Dartmouth, Lord Chamberlain of His Majesty's Household, who was knighted by the Sovereign with the Sword of State, and thereupon withdrew.

The Knights Companions then proceeded to the Election; and the Suffrages being collected by the Register, and the bunnages being concetted by the Register, and prefented to the Sovereign, George Earl of Dartmouth was, by His Majeity's Com-mand, declared duly elected. His Lordship was thereupon received at the Door of the Chapter-Room by the Two Junior Knights Companions, and conducted between them to the Sovereign, preceded by Garter, bearing the Enfigns of the Order on a Culhion.

His Majefty, affifted by the Two Senior Knights Companions, buckled it on the Earl's Left Leg, the Register pronouncing the Admonition.

Garter then prefented the Ribband with the George to the Sovereign ; and, the Earl kneeling, the Sovereign, with the Affiftance of the faid Two Senior Knights Companions, put it over His Lordship's Shoulder, the Register, in the mean Time, pronouncing the Admonition, and His Lordship having killed His Majesty's Hand, and faluted the

Knights prefent, withdrew. The Chapter ended, Garter called over the Knights, and a Procession was made back to His

Majefty's Apartment in the Order as before. The Queen, Their Royal Highneffes the Princeffes, and many Ladies and other Perfons of Diftinction, were prefent.

A fplendid Entertainment was provided for the Knights Companions, to which the Officers of the Order had the Honor of being invited.
