Gullavus Adolphus, Sc .- To the Regency of Pomerania, relative to the Right of warehousing Englifh Goods.

Y an Agreement that has taken place between . Us and His Britannic Majefty, We have granted to the Subjects of His Britannic Majefty the Right, during the Continuance of the War between Great Britain and France, of warehoufing at Stral-fund all Goods and Merchandize, unwrought or manufactured, the Produce of Great Britain or of its Colonies, conveyed in English or in Swedish Veffels, fuch Merchandize being subject, if for Re-exportation by Land or by Sea, to a Duty not exceeding Three Quarters per Cent. ad valorem; and if for
