May 14, 1805.*

SIR,

I BEG to acquaint you, that the Spanish Schooner La Felix, a Letter of Marque, pierced for Ten Guns, but only Six mounted, with a Complement of Forty-two Men, commanded by Francisco Lopes, laden with Coffee and Bees Wax, from the Havanna to Vera Cruz, was this Day captured by His Majesty's Ship under my Command, after a Chace of Four Hours.

She sailed the preceding Evening, and was permitted to do so from her very great Superiority of sailing, and is the first Vessel that has quitted that Anchorage, since the Embargo was laid on.
